Another large entry but far fewer meat cows forward. Nevertheless all grades met a fantastic trade with the very best types selling extremely well. Even those lacking flesh or straight out of the dairy sold very well for their type and condition. Many more wanted particularly younger meat sorts.

**BEEF COWS (35) Max: 174.50p/kg & £1,399**

An outstanding Charolais from PW Fry & Son topped the day at 174.5p/kg and £1399. Other top quality cows included a Hereford from JW Steele & Son that peaked at 170.5p/kg. Other smart Herefords sold very well to 138.5p/kg and grossing over £1278 from WJ Witt & Son, 142.5p/kg from SH Harris & Son and 163.5p/kg from RF Stratton & Co. Well presented Simmentals peaked at 163.5p/kg from JE Cock & Son with others easily to 159p/kg and £1063 from E Coombes. Limousins closely followed at 159.5p/kg from W & C Lasbury. Plenty of other Continental regularly sold in advance of 130p/kg and more would have sold very well on this flying trade.

**DAIRY COWS (75) Max: 149.00p/kg & £1,180**

The quality Friesian meat cows were in short supply and very keenly contested with the best to 149p/kg from R Targett and £1180 from KJ Osborne & Partners. Other easily to 143.5p/kg from Padfield & Dyke, 143p/kg from WL Baxandall, 141.5p/kg from NJ Emery & Sons and 138.5p/kg from both RL & CJ Curtis and WJ Masters & Son. Over 20 sold in advance of 130p/kg nearly of half of which grossed over £1000. The plainer manufacturing sorts were also dear from 90p/kg with very few settling at lower levels.
