Continental outfits met a good demand with a smart consignment from Green Lane Farming peaking at £1380 for an Angus cow with Limousin steer calf at foot. Hereford cows with Angus heifer calves wanted from £1020 to £1150 presented by Read Farming. Pedigree Hereford outfits from Wilsco Ltd topped at £1220. Pedigree Devon bulling heifers topped at £1130 from CR Wyatt. A number of bulls on offer this week with Pedigree Herefords to £1760 from Jamie's Farm. Pedigree Angus to £1700 from Green Lane Farming and Pedigree Shorthorns to £1200 from H Gates.

The best calved heifers were easily sold with Holstein Friesians to £1630 from KAM Farming. Tony Leighton secured top spot with his quality Holsteins to £1700. The average types also met plenty of competitive bidding from £1200 to £1400. The plainer sorts saw no shortage of bidders with most from £1000 to £1150. Young cows (2nd & 3rd Lactation) produced one of the liveliest trades seen in recent week with cracking sorts to £1840 and £1630 from Tony Leighton. Nice cows from KAM Farming to £1600 and £1580. Viv and Gill Doggrell continue to disperse their herd with their 3rd and 4th lactation cows to £1520 today. Bulling heifers to £660 also from KAM Farming. Weaned young stock met a tremendous trade with cross bred heifers (4mo) to an excellent £360 from JM & DE Ovens.

Another good sized entry met an equally marvellous trade as seen in recent weeks. The well presented fleshed cattle sparked very competitive bidding and more would have sold to advantage. The average cattle sold in accordance to type with the best under 36 month sorts meeting the best demand.

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided. If you run a number of bulls of different breeds, we advise either keeping the bulls separate or DNA testing the calves to make sure the correct breed and sire is selected at time of registration. **If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a registered sire.**
