CALVED HEIFERS TO £1,850 CALVED COWS TO £1,310

Once again a strong entry in the dairy section and plenty of demand for all classes today from freshly calved to yearling heifers. A grand consignment of 9 freshly calved Holstein Friesian heifers from regular vendors W L Baxandall IOW, which produced an average of £1682 and topped at £1750. 5 of the entry topped at £1700. Super calved pedigree Shorthorn heifers from the same vendor sold well to £1810 and £1720. Cross bred Jersey x heifers presented by Brian Fielding were wanted to £1000 twice. Excellent 3rd calved Ayrshire x cows from the Bennett family saw lively bidding at £1310. A grand consignment of 14 in calf Holstein Friesian heifers and cows from the Kane family at Ringwood produced strong prices throughout. Their Holstein Friesian heifers due Aug/Sept to Red Aberdeen Angus averaged £1268, 5 times over £1200 and twice over £1400 to top at £1460. Ayrshire in calf heifers to £1140, Holstein Friesian in calf cows due Aug/Sept at £1000 – £1170. Included in this sale was a quality entry of 30 dairy young stock 12-14mo from D Mortimer & Sons from Melksham. Trade was very firm and a good number of buyers were present and looking for cattle. Prices ranged £410 - £660 according to age and size on offer.
