A cracking entry of quality suckler cattle for our special August sale with bidding very competitive from start to finish. The sale commenced with a special dispersal of Continental x cows with calves



at foot from Mike Osborne & family, Weston. The Osborne family's hard work and dedication over the years was clearly evident in the quality of stock he presented for sale. Buyers from near and farm packed the ringside and trade



was buoyant throughout with the best outfits selling to £1900 with plenty from £1800 to average around £1600 across the board. In-calf cows from the same home wanted to £1120 for Simmentals PD+ in-calf to a Pedigree Hereford. Other entries met an equally pleasing demand with Pedigree Shorthorn outfits to £1250 from WJ Locke. A Limousin x cow with steer calf at foot from Stowford Manor sold well to £1400 whilst a smart Angus outfit from Ray & Russell Cox also settled at £1400. Angus cows with young Blue calves to £1300 from R Lewis. Herefords from B Calder met a brisk trade with young steer calf outfits to £1260 and others in advance of £1100. Pedigree maiden Hereford heifers from Valley Farm Contracting topped at £1200 with most from £900. A run of smart Pedigree Hereford bulls from the same home topped at £2220 with their younger ones easily from £1100. Young Simmental bulls from Halomark Ltd settled at £1240 whilst a Pedigree Parthenaise from P Webber reached £1300. A very well bred high health status Pedigree Limousin from Mark and Kate Lanfear topped the bull trade at £2500.
