CALVED HEIFERS TO £1,950 CALVED COWS TO £1,500

A fantastic entry in the dairy section this week. There was a complete range of dairy from freshly calved heifers and cows to in calf heifers, bulling heifers, yearlings and calves. The auction ring was full to capacity and bidding was brisk throughout the sale. Freshly calved heifers were very much in demand but quality was king. AF Leighton topped the sale with his superb calved Holstein heifer at £1,950 and very closely followed by W.L Baxandall's calved Holstein Friesian heifers IOW, were 4 times over £1,700 and twice over £1,800 topping at £1,860. More IOW cattle from Calbourne Classics saw a good firm trade £1100 - £1300. Calved Jersey x heifers to a strong trade at £900. Included in the sale was a super consignment of Pedigree in milk and dry Holstein Friesians from Sussex. Buyers were keen for these well presented home bred cattle from a 10,000th herd. In calf heifers £1100 - £1150 while 2nd & 3rd lactating in calf and in milk cows were regularly over £1300 topping at an excellent £1500! Cross bred in calf heifers were all well sold with a consignment from Simon Martin Farms out of pattern Swedish Red and Jersey x regularly over £1000 to £1180, stronger Jersey x to £920.

Also on offer today was a grand entry of 70 youngstock from Holland Farms, Dorchester. Trade for these home bred Holstein heifers was very bright ranging in age from 5mo – 17mo producing an average of £609! And regularly to £650. Top quality home bred Friesian Holstein bulling heifers presented by Henry Rawlings and family peaked at a strong £750. Overall a marvellous day in the dairy section at Frome and thanks to all who supported the sale this week.
