The best Holsteins topped at 153p/kg (£1378) from PB Weeks & Son with others easily to 148p/kg (£1192) from WJ Masters & Sons, 144.5p/kg (£911) from D & G A'Bear Farming, 142p/kg (£1138) from Padfield & Dyke and 142p/kg (£1090) from EB Holloway & Son. BRIGHT TRADE FOR LOCAL DAIRY DISPERSAL

CALVED COWS TO £1,722

Monday 14th August saw Cooper & Tanner Auctioneers disperse the herd of Friesian Holstein cows for the Messrs W & R Arney, Rode, Frome. Demand was brisk for these deep bodied Holsteins which were predominantly home bred and manged on a commercial basis being milked twice daily through a Tandem parlour. The July/August calved heifers and 2nd lactation cows were particularly sought with top spot going to an "Oman Loydie" sired 2nd lactation cow at £1722. Heifers produced a good competitive trade achieving over £1400 on no less than 11 occasions. Quality "Altaclassman" sired heifers peaked at £1625. Older dams (3rd to 5th lactation) were all easily sold from £1000 to £1200 on a regular basis. Overall the herd averaged £1100.
