## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### **BEEF SCHEMES – NAMED SIRE**

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market.

Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If you run a number of registered bulls of the same breed, please make sure you either specify which bull sired which animal or provide all possibilities on your entry form at point of sale.

If you run a number of bulls of different breeds, we advise either keeping the bulls separate or DNA testing the calves to make sure the correct breed and sire is selected at time of registration.

**If at point of sale you are not 100% sure,  
please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a registered sire.**

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale  
will be considerable.

An online database to check whether your sire is registered as pedigree is available on most cattle society websites. Please contact the market office for further clarification or information regarding sire names.

### **BEEF FARM ASSURANCE**

We strongly advise that all vendors are registered with an approved farm assurance body (SAI Global, NSF-CMi, Acoura) to take advantage of the premium achieved for farm assured cattle at point of sale.
