A large entry of dairy cows met another very fast trade with both Holstein and British sections average well over 100p/kg. Over 20 cows sold in advance of 135p/kg with over half of these grossing over £1000. A good run of heavy meat cows from Crutchley Farms average over 128p/kg despite a number of imports. Their best cows topped at 149p/kg with other regularly in the 130p/kg to 140p/kg. Well presented cows from RGE Durston grossed over £1400 twice settling at £1494 and £1443. Other good Friesians easily to 148.5p/kg from Nunton Farms, 148p/kg from HM Isaac & Son, 143p/kg from D & G A'Bear Farming and 142p/kg from S Sargent. The manufacturing cows were also dearer and even the very plain and poor met a strong trade for their type.
