CALVED HEIFERS TO £2,150 CALVED COWS TO £1,850

A wonderful show of dairy cattle this week with over 80 head penned for sale. As well as our normal weekly consignment we were favoured with the dispersal sale of the "Attwoods" herd of prize winning **Pedigree** Dairy Shorthorns on behalf of Messrs Garratt & Mannerings Winchester. The ring was full to capacity with purchasers travelling from as far as Southern Ireland, Wales and Lincolnshire to see these quality types. As expected the herd was of the highest quality and very well presented by the dedicated family. Demand was very strong throughout with all selling at excellent levels. The breeding lines descended from the "Foggathorpe" "Rosebud" and "Rodway" herds and were highly sought after. Top spot went to "Attwoods Grey Rose 2nd" selling to an excellent £2150...sired by "Nejay Ernie" she certainly stole



the show (*photo right*). "Rosebud 8th" closely followed sire by "Gelli Ipod Discoverer" and calved in July to her first settled at £1960. July calved (2nd lactation) "Attwoods Tabia 2nd" saw brisk bidding to £1860 (*photo left*). Dry cows produced equal interest with "Rodway Grey Rose 26th" by "Attwell Atom" easily to £1500. Bulling heifers from the same consignment topped at £900. Quality Pedigree Shorthorn in-calf heifers from WH & RJ Rawlins peaked at £1250 with their bulling heifers from the same "Ablington" herd regularly from £800 to £890.

The **commercial** section met an equally lively trade with Tony Leighton achieving in excess of £1500 for all his British Friesian, Ayrshire and Shorthorn heifers. Older calved loose housed Friesian Holstein cows from W Rossiter (ceasing milk production) easily settled at £1250 with 5th lactation cows to £900. Swedish Red x calved cows (3rd lactation) from Mrs Thistlewood topped at a strong £1200. A super consignment of in-calf Holstein heifers presented by Calbourne Classics, Isle of Wight, created keen interest topping at £1510 with plenty over £1200. Older October/November cows due to Holstein Friesians from East Close Farms averaged £1000 topping at £1220.

The quality well fleshed steers met another fierce demand with the best over 200p/kg and £1200. Smart Continentals from JC Stainer set the trade with his Limousins peaked at 201.5p/kg and Charolais at 194.5p/kg. Other framed Limousins easily to £1466 from Sue Bishop. Other Continentals generally from 180p/kg with only the lean poorer sorts settling at lower levels. The named sire Angus and Herefords continue to spark interest settling either side of the 200p/kg mark. Plenty more of all breeds showing good conformation and flesh would have sold well.

A much larger entry than last week with all grades and breeds in demand to average 120p/kg. The best fleshed types as expected sparked very brisk bidding with many more wanted on a weekly basis. The number of plain poorer sorts straight out the dairy also sold well for their type.

BEEF COWS (17) Max: 159.00p/kg & £1,244

A very small but good quality entry met a flying demand with the best easily over 140p/kg and £1000. Cracking Herefords from MJ & RD Russell topped at 159p/kg and 158.5p/kg grossing over £1200. Limousins closely followed at 153.5p/kg and £1220 from S & H Webb with Blues to 150.5p/kg and £1065 from Bryant & Bryant and Simmentals to 150p/kg from J Hares. Angus to 137.5p/kg from BJ & DJ Reeves. Plenty more fleshed beef cows would have sold to advantage on this strong trade. Even those lacking flesh sold well for their type.
