BEEF COWS (42) Max: 174.00p/kg & £1,390

A much stronger entry of beef cows than of late and vendors were well rewarded for marketing their good quality cows. Smart Limousins from Ashley Chase Estates topped at 174p/kg with Angus from the same home easily to 167.5p/kg. Well fleshed Simmentals easily to 162.5p/kg from RE Dury & Son with quality Blondes from D & R Miller & Son peaking at 158p/kg whose smart consignment averaged over 147p/kg. A nice run of Continentals from Church Farm Publow LLP sparked keen interest to average 144p/kg topping at 156p/kg.

Another sensational trade for the dairy types this week with Montbeliardes topping at 152.5p/kg from Ashley Chase Estates.
