The recent rains really making a difference this week. Quality sorts all selling at premium levels and others all a little dearer on the week. Prices were outstanding with both dairy and suckler bred cattle wanted. Top Blue x steers 8 mo out of Friesian x types from JT Jackson and family met a strong trade at £855 - £875. More grand sorts from GH Elliot and Co Bridgwater, peaked at £895 - £910. 12 mo heifers from the same home at £655. Chris Hannam and Son Sherborne presenting a consignment of quality Limousin suckler bred steers 11-12 mo £910. Blues from the same home at £880, £905 and £990. Rob Fry and family once again producing outstanding suckled Charolais steers peaking at £1005. John and Mrs Marklove continuing to enter the very best of Simmentals 14 mo which saw steers to £1135 and heifers to £910. Andrew Gale saw his outwintered quality Limousin steers 13 mo £895 - £960.

HEREFORDS

A tremendous entry of Herefords today which were wanted. Cracking forward steers from D Flux and C Griffin topped at £1,112. Younger steers from £938 to £950 J & S Farming Ltd. Younger steers were well sold and enjoyed spirited bidding. Quality consignments of bulling heifers met a fast trade regularly selling over £800 with younger heifers to £835 from John and Stella Farming, £880 Steve Bailey, £885 D Flux and C Griffin and £890 Kingspall Farming Ltd.

ABERDEEN ANGUS

All Angus sold to a flying trade for all types. A cracking steer from Kingsplay Farming topped the trade at £1345 followed by £1250 from Ingsdon Farming. Angus heifers to £1140 for a smart heifer from Andrew Gale with plenty of other types over £1000. Fast bidding for younger steers and heifers with quality consignments from I & J Homes to £840 for 8 mo. Well bred sorts with frames and potential from Andrew Burrows to £775. Other quality steers from CJ Yorke to £850 for 9 mo.

DEVON

South Devon yearling steers 8 mo sold well to £902 and heifers to £715 all from Potticks Pigs Ltd. Other heifers to £714 from DAM Marklove and their steers to £900.

FRIESIANS

Well grown consignments of Friesians sold to a brisk trade. Forward British types to £965 from Paul Hurd with a good consignment of Holstein Friesians from Tony Rich reached £872. Similar large framed types to £870. Slightly smaller well bred steers from Kingsplay Farming to £802. Younger Friesians in high demand for several buyers. Friesians, Norwegians and Fleckveih from Green Lanes Farming to £505 for 6 months.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Quality continues at a premium. Fierce bidding for well grown for age with quality consignment of 20–22 months from Crockermoor Farm Partnership selling to advantage. Their British Blue steers met a fast trade from £1150 - £1170. Their Limousin steers sold to £1195 and Blondes to £1198. Younger British Blues equally wanted with Ryan House's to £1090. The good range of Simmental steers equally sought from £1035 from S King Ltd, £1055 from DM Vaughan and £1135 only 14months from DAM Mark Love. Young Charolais sold to £1005 from Rob Fry. Heifers wanted and sold well with the quality range of Limousin heifers from £1040 Steve Bailey, £1042 Andrew Gale and £1068 from Paul Hurd. Simmental heifers met fast bidding with younger types over £900 and topped at £1042 from Steve Bailey. British Blue heifers sold well from £1000 Kingsplay Farming Ltd to £1060 from KF Romain. Bullers regularly selling over £900 from numerous vendors.
