HEIFERS TO £1,140

A good sized entry which commenced with a run of Pedigree Angus suckler cows and calves from Vastern Farms. These older cows sold well for their type and regularly settled in advance of £800 topping at £940.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another good entry of young Continentals met a buoyant trade with the well presented types sparking very brisk bidding. A cracking consignment from GM & S Silvester & Sons set the trade with their dairy bred Simmental steers topping at a massive £912 and their heifers to £780. Blue steers from GH Elliott & Co topped at £892 with heifers to £795 from S Lloyd-Harris. Other Continental steers regularly sold in advance of £700 with Limousins to £835 from Hares Partnership. Cracking Limousin heifers from MF Deacon topped at £928 and more of these quality sorts would have sold to advantage.

ANGUS / HEREFORDS

The **Angus** cattle continue to sell very well particularly those with a named sire and from a farm assured holing. The younger cattle set the trade with smart steers from S Lloyd-Harris topping at £895 with others easily to £892 from CG & CJ Bicknell and £885 from Mick Silvester. Similar aged heifers topped at a massive £922 again from S Lloyd-Harris. Other yearling heifers generally from £650 to £750. The stronger Angus met a flying demand with steers topping at £1195 from Roger Martin & Graham Few. Others sold very well to £1080 from Michael Flux, £1068 from S Lloyd-Harris and £1000 Lulworth Castle Farms. Forward heifers more scarce with the best to £1045 from FF & J Down and £972 from Roger Martin & Graham Few. More would have sold to advantage. Some well presented forward **Hereford** steers topped at £1090 from S Lloyd-Harris and £1022 from Ingsdon Farm. Younger steers (12-15mo) generally settled around in advance of £750 peaking at £898 for very smart types from Lulworth Castle Farms. No older Hereford heifers on offer but the well presented younger types sold well to £885 from S Lloyd-Harris and £852 from Nick Hillier.

FRIESIANS

The younger Friesians met a solid trade with a strong run from Mick Silvester selling well to £688. Other yearling types settled around the £500 mark. The stronger Friesians topped at £930 from RC Few & Sons with others to £928 from the same home. Younger sorts equally sought to £900 from Michael Flux and £895 from Mick Silvester. Medium farming types met a firm demand around £700.
