ANGUS

There was no problem selling Angus today and many more could have easily been sold. The younger dairy types saw steers from £700 to £850 while heifers sold from £600 to £700. More forward cattle were desperately wanted and strong steers peaked at £1050. Heifers were generally better quality today and some grand sorts were all over £1000 from DO Webb and PW, CC & JC Gould.

HEREFORDS

All Herefords very dear and the limited numbers on offer were showing good conformation. Good numbers of younger Herefords were on top spot with plenty of steers ranging from £700 to £800. Younger heifers in short supply but wanted. Older Herefords very dear and prices in excess of £1000 were regularly achieved.

FRIESIANS

Only a limited number forward but plenty of demand and prices were at top levels. Stronger sorts saw prices in excess of £900 with buyers keen for all types.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A tremendously exciting trade for the forward continentals presented for sale. GR Hemmens again seeing the Blondes to £1110 while Mr Raymond saw his outstanding Blonde steer top at £1170. Dairy x British Blue steers once again over £1000 and saw good competitive bidding. A number of well fleshed quality heifers were on offer which regularly sold between £950 to £1000. Overall more wanted to meet this wonderful trade.

BEEF SCHEMES: NAMED SIRES

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
