### YOUNG CONTINENTALS

All the young Continentals sold very well throughout the day and buyers are clearly looking for quality stock. **STEERS:** Plenty of well presented steers sold in advance of £750 with cracking Limousins (10-11mo) to £808 from Mells Park Trust and £810 from MJ Freeman. Charolais and Blue steers met a very buoyant trade to £852 from SJ Crossman and £885 from E & M Seare respectively. Outstanding single suckled Simmentals (12mo) from GW & M Pike & Son were a highlight with their best to £995. **HEIFERS:** Smart Blues topped at £870 from JH & GA Breach with others to £778 from E & M Seare. Simmentals from AL & DM Sage & Son peaked at £780. There was a larger percentage of dairy bred sorts than of late on offer this week and all commanded brisk bidding from £570 to £660.

## **HEREFORDS (96)**

A brisk trade for the younger Hereford cattle today with far too few on offer to satisfy demand. The handful of harder out wintered sorts available sold well with steers to £762 from RE & D Woodward and heifers to £572 from RD & CM Stevens. The larger selection of forward Herefords sparked very brisk bidding with steers easily over £1000. Fleshed steers topped at £1150 from RJ Sparshott with others to £1100 from D & O Coombes and £1095 from Puncknowle Manor Estate. Forward heifers equally sought to £968 from Holland Farms Ltd.

## ANGUS (83)

As always the Angus cattle continue to command a premium and many more named sire farm assured types would have sold to advantage. Young well bred suckled steers (10mo) from W Tyrwhitt-Drake topped at £910 with their heifers to £690. Other quality types sparked brisk bidding with steers from E & M Seare to £900 and £855 from GT White & Son. Equally well presented heifers (12-15mo) were in demand to £825 from MJ Coleman & Son and £800 from JH & GA Breach. The dairy bred younger cattle met a brighter trade than of late and those showing potential were particularly wanted. The stronger forward Angus met a fantastic trade with the very best selling in advance of £1100. Cracking heavy weights topped at £1185 from Ray Cock with others easily to £1150 from D & O Coombes. Other smart steers settled at £1090 from Knapp Farm Ltd, £1080 from RC Few & Sons and £1058 from S Bailey. Well fleshed heifers equally sought but more scarce with the best to £1010 from S Bailey and £985 again from D & O Coombes. Lighter farming heifers generally settled between £750 and £850.

## DEVONS / S'HORNS (57)

Plenty of buyers are looking to source quality traditional bred cattle and are willing to pay for the right types. A wonderful consignment of South Devon x young steers (10-12mo) from Mells Park Trust were very keenly contested selling over £830 (eighteen times) with the best pen of eight cattle topping at £895. Some quality Shorthorns from Tony Sage met a cracking trade with his steers (9-11mo) to £870.

## FRIESIANS (79)

A good selection of Friesians this week with buyers showing more interest than of late. The stronger framed cattle topped at £1015 from Paul Hurd and £1000 from Holland Farms Ltd. Farming sorts generally settled either side of the £780 mark with younger types to £688 from E & M Seare.

## FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Another good entry of well presented fleshed cattle met a flying trade with the best easily selling in advance of £1000. **STEERS:** Limousins from Paul Hurd set the trade at £1090 with a tremendous entry from Puncknowle Manor Estate easily from £1100 to £1170. A quality run of Simmentals sparked brisk bidding from £1130 from Ray Cock to £1160 from Stuart & Lorna King. Charolais met a flying trade with younger sorts to £1150 again from Stuart & Lorna King and £1015 from CJ Yorke. British Blues were a highlight with several good consignments selling from £1110 from Trinity Farm Seagry Ltd and £1140 from D & O Coombes. The best of the day were from Stuart & Lorna King who achieved prices from £1175 to £1255. **HEIFERS:** Another sensational trade with Blues easily to £1120 from D & O Coombes and £1100 from FF & J Down. Simmentals equally sought to £1120 from Ray Cock and £1050 from Tony Sage. Younger sorts met a brisk demand with Limousins to £998 from Puncknowle Manor Estate and £1050 from RC Few & Sons.
