A few more cows and calves this week comprising a nice consignment of out of calving pattern Limousin x outfits from D & R Miller & Son. Trade was lively with the best sets from £1200 to £1510. Buyers very much looking for quality and competitively bid for these smart types. The older cows with calves generally from £850 to £1000.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

The large consignments of single suckled calves now coming to an end but those on offer still met plenty of demand. Super Simmental Steers (6mo) from Lockerley Hall Farms achieved an outstanding price of £790. A strong entry of mainly Charolais calves (6-8mo) from Robert & Julia Banwell created very lively prices from £750 with their best steers to £850 and their heifers to £775. A grand consignment of Simmentals and Blues (6-8mo) from RM & JE Brown were very keenly contested with their Simmental steers to £770 and heifers to £695. Blue heifers from the same home easily to £732. Top quality Blue steers (9-10mo) presented by regularly support Clive House sold well to £835 with cracking types to £880 from AG Coles & Son. Well presented cattle from Will Stitch were a highlight with his Limousin steers to £875 and Charolais heifers to £795. Overall another good day in this section.

ANGUS

The Angus cattle continuing to command a premium with the single suckled types particularly wanted. Top young sorts (7mo) from I & J Holmes & Co saw prices top at £792 with others to a tremendous £825 from T & S Brown. The strongest yearling steers keenly contested to £885 from Will Stitch. Yearling heifers perhaps not quite the quality of previous weeks but all forward sold to a keen audience from £590 to £630. The dairy bred types also met a solid trade but buyers were more selective. The forward cattle met a flying trade with the best steers today easily to £1170 from Clyffe Farms with others from the same home to £1070. Smart steers from N Stone closely followed at £1055. Fleshed Angus heifers also met plenty of interest with the best to £992 from new vendor J & C Rawlings. Other bulling heifers generally from £850. Overall another bright trade.

HEREFORDS

An excellent entry of over 200 head of Herefords met a cracking trade with the best fleshed steers topping at £1150 from Peter & Sue Ings with others to £1080 from FW Selby. Medium framed

steers equally sought to £830 from Michael Flux and DW Hodges, £842 from Peter Read, £875 from John Godwin and £915 from VJ Pearce. Yearling steers sold well to £735 from RF Stratton & Co, £718 from CJ Stokes & Sons with slightly stronger types to £752 from John Coleman & Sons, £770 from Harvey Coles, £792 from S Ellmers, £798 from Jane Trott and £812 from WE Love & Son. Heifers met an equally buoyant demand with the best fleshed types to £935 from Jane Trott. Several consignments of bullers sold from £700 to £760 from Tom Bravin and £790 from W Rousell. Younger heifers in demand to £520 from CJ Stokes & Sons, £580 from S Ellmers and £628 from AJ Scott & Sons.

FRIESIANS

The better heavier steers today peaked at £850 from Paul Hurd with medium farming types to £755 from BW Ewins & Partners. The younger types wanted ranging from £500 from Richard Salter to £600 from RF Stratton & Co.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A good selection of well reared cattle on offer today with all breeds sparking a flying trade with several consignments settling over £1100. Limousin steers were a highlight selling to a massive £1248 from Michael Miller T/A Longclose Farm with others to £1160 and £1130 from Charlie Coleman T/A Clyffe Farms. Simmental steers equally sought from £1115 from Michael Flux to £1120 from Clyffe Farms and £1150 from Betty Chiswell. Her fleshed Charolais also sold well to £1135 with stronger types to £1160 from Clyffe Farms and £1205 from Longclose Farm. Blue steers from Longclose Farm met a cracking demand to £1100 with the best from £1155 from £1175 from Clyffe Farms. Heifers met a strong trade with bidding brisk throughout with more wanted to satisfy demand. Quality Blues wanted to £920 from Longclose Farm with younger well grown types to £815 from C & W Hannam & Son. Younger Limousins from the same home to £825. Well grown Simmentals to £810 from Ingsdon Farm, £830 from N Stone and £865 from Keith and Karen Greenslade.
