SUCKLER CATTLE

A good sized entry of Suckler cows and calves this week with all meeting a brisk trade. The stronger bodied cows with young calves at foot in particular sparked keen interest. A well presented entry from Mrs Manyweathers of Simmental, Limousin and Pedigree Hereford cows with calves at foot were keenly contested selling 6 times over £1100 and 3 times over £1200. Pedigree Hereford bulling heifers from the same consignment sold extremely well to £1000 and yearling easily to £700. Plainer Continental x and Angus x Cows with Angus calves (1mo) at foot generally from £850 to £1000.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another phenomenal trade for the younger Continentals today with some marvellous cattle coming through the ring. Two big consignments of quality cattle from Julian and Kate Phillips (Kingsdown Farm Ltd) and the Parsons family (A Parsons & Son Farming Ltd). Trade was electric from start to finish with Kingsdown Farm's 90 Charolais and Simmental steers and heifers (10-12mo) topping at £1045 and £865. Equally smart types from A Parsons & Son Farming Ltd were keenly contested with their Charolais steers to £910 and Limousin heifers to £770. Cracking Devon steers from MJ Blow topped the section at £1050 with smart Simmentals to £1025 from NM Doggrell. The dairy bred cattle also met a bright trade and more of these would have sold to advantage.

BEEF SCHEMES – NAMED SIRES

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

HEREFORDS

Another good selection of Hereford cattle with the named sire farm assured types sparking the strongest interest. Forward steers topped at £1048 from HP & J Flux with others easily to £955 from Jane Trott and £935 from Manor Farm Partnership. Medium farming steers generally from to £880 from Spratling & Son with well-fed sorts to £912 from Symondsburly Estate. Yearling steers wanted from £650 topping at £780 again from Spratling and Son. The selection of forward heifers met flying trade topping at £1075 from LP Shackell & Son with others easily to £1005 from Jane Trott. Quality bulling sorts to £870 from HP & J Flux, £855 from Symondsburly Estate and £850 from GD Goddard. Yearling heifers a little more scarce but wanted to £725 again from Jane Trott.

ANGUS

A large entry once again this week with all ages and grades continuing to command a premium particularly those that are farm assured and named sired. Well grown forward steers from PW CC & JC Gould and the Parsons family easily to £1032 with the best to £1070 from NJ Stone. Other framed types keenly contested to £955 from Arthur Eastment and £935 from Manor Farm Partnership. The younger yearling steers met strong bidding from £870 to £875 from MJ Blow. Heifers met an equally buoyant demand with forward types to £942 from T Harrison. Plenty of medium bulling sorts sold from £850 to £895 from FF & J Down and JK Simpson and £878 from VL Vincent & Son. Yearling heifers met very good trade to £845 from Kingsdown Farm Ltd.

FRIESIANS

Not quite so many forward types this week with stronger farming sorts topping at £815 from DR & JL Selby. Plenty of medium framed types settled between £600 and £650 mark with nice types to £660 from C & G Tayler and £655 from HP & J Flux. Yearling steers to £500 from WH Perry & Son.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Once again some cracking Continental cattle presented for sale with bidding brisk from start to finish. **STEERS:** Fleshed Charolais sold very well from £1245 to £1252 from A Parsons & Son Farming Ltd. Younger Simmentals met an exceptional bright demand to £1095. Limousins equally sought to £1105 from PW CC & JC Gould and Blues to £1102 from Tom Voizey. Plenty of other good steers easily sold in advance of £1000. **HEIFERS:** Another tremendous trade with many more wanted to satisfy demand. Fleckvieh heifers from Tom Voizey topped at a fantastic £1090 with smart Limousins closely following at £1078 from Church Farm Publow LLP. Charolais presented by Kingsdown Farm Ltd peaked at £1045. Younger sorts with bulling potential wanted from £800.
