YOUNG CONTINENTALS

The New Year has certainly started with a very lively trade. The better single suckled steers and heifers realised prices up by £50 to £75 a head compared to late November/December time. Demand was strong for all breeds with nice Charolais and Simmental steers from Lockerley Hall Farm just shy of the £800 mark. Heifers were particularly wanted with nice Blondes to £765 from TG Cox. The dairy bred sorts were also dearer than of late and more would have sold to advantage.

The Hereford cattle realised some very good prices today with buyers clearly wanting these traditional types. No forward types on offer but a super run of 30 young steers and heifers showing good conformation from Tom Bravin were keenly sought to £768 and £632.

There were some nice Angus cattle presented for sale this week with the named sire and farm assured types particularly wanted. Well presented medium framed steers from GR Barnett and Hunton Farm Partnership settled at £860 and £858 respectively. Similar framed heifers with farming potential met a brisk demand to £840 again from Hunton Farm Partnership. Younger Angus sparked keen interest and regularly sold in advance of £700 with steers to £752 from Giddings Bros.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Demand for the stronger Continental cattle was excellent but unfortunately there were far too few on offer to satisfy demand. Many more would have sold to advantage on this trade. The best British Blue x steers from D Hayward peaked at a massive £1260. Nice fleshed medium framed heifers from VJ White easily settled at £880.

Only a handful of Friesians this week with strong British types easily to £1050 from PW Keen & Sons.
