YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Today saw the first of our large consignments of single suckled Continental calves from West Amesbury Farms (100 Charolais), D & R Miller & Son (70 Limousins) and NB Needham & Sons (85 Limousins). These smart types (6-8mo) were all of the highest quality and very keenly contested. Grand Charolais steers (5-6mo) from West Amesbury Farms regularly sold from £700 to £800 with their heifers from £635 to £700. Their best topped at an excellent £770. Top quality Limousin steers and heifers from D & R Miller & Son and NB Needham & Sons created marvellous interest with prices settling at very strong levels for these well bred and presented types. Steers from the Miller family averaged £828 topping at £842 whilst their heifers averaged £705 and topped at £735. Top quality sorts from Mark Needham met a blistering trade with almost all his steers selling in advance of £800 with the best pen (only 6mo) to £892. The sensational demand continued with his heifers that regularly sold between £700 and £780 topping at £818. Plenty of other good cattle presented today with shapely home bred Blues (6mo) from Tim Handy easily to £805 for his steers and £680 for his heifers. Too many more good types to mention this week but a wonderful trade from start to finish for our first calf sale this Autumn. The dairy bred Continentals showing good conformation and potential were also well sold with buyers prepared to pay for the better types.

ANGUS

The named sire and farm assured Angus continue to command a premium with the more wanted to satisfy another flying demand. The stronger fleshed medium steers today topped at £995 from PJ Pobjoy & Son with others to £958 from Freeman Bros and £950 from Paul & Tim Wilkinson. Cracking young steers (15mo) from R Sayer to £948 with others to £938 from D Powell. Forward heifers sold well to £1048 from Humphrey Shackell with other good farming sorts £955 from CG Pulsford & Partners and £950 from Roger Few. Yearlings again from R Sayer easily to £870 with others to £842 from D Powell and £775 from NP Hayward.

HEREFORDS

A smaller entry of Herefords than seen of late. Strong fleshed steers topped at £1128 from AG & RV Rossiter with others to £1045 and £1040 from the same home. Other good types with potential wanted to £960 from RFW & KJ Cook, £915 from HG Davey and £890 from Paul & Tim Wilkinson.

The few younger steers topped at £798 from BK & A Garrett & Son with heifers to £652 from Jamies Farm. Stronger heifers topped at £950 from BK & A Garrett & Son and £942 from Humphrey Shackell. More of all ages with named sires would have sold to advantage.

FRIESIANS

Not too many forward this week as our large runs of suckled calf sales get underway. Trade generally settled at prices expected at this time of year with the better framed types with potential meeting solid interest. Good feeding steers topped at £775 from Tony Heath with British types to £750 from R James. Well presented younger sorts wanted to £715 from NP Hayward.

Younger suckled Limousins equally sought to £1042 from Neville Coffin & family. Smart Simmentals met a massive trade to £1118 from Malcolm & Abbey Robinson with Charolais to £1062 from CM Currell and £1080 from John & Sue Loder. Good feeding Blues wanted with younger sorts from £1000 from Golden Valley Farm, £1020 from Malcolm & Abbey Robinson to £1045 from Paul & Tim Wilkinson. **HEIFERS:** Charolais from Neville Coffin & family were a highlight selling from £940 to £1170. Limousins keenly contested to £972 from Pat Apsey, Blues to £922 from Phil Parfitt and £980 from both Malcolm & Abbey Robinson and Humphrey Shackell. Blondes also in demand to £910 from JJ Taylor & Son. More would have sold to a flying trade.

BREEDING EWES (262)

A good sized entry sold to a very firm trade with all breeds and grades wanted. Top price of the day went to a fantastic consignment of Blue Texel ewes from Eastbury Livestock selling to £218 and £212. Some useful runs of 2T ewes traded well with North Country Mules to £125 twice from Padfield & Dyke whilst Suffolk x Mules met plenty of interest to £116 twice from W Bush & Co. Older ewes well sold with strong Suffolk x Mules (4T/6T) to £102 and Charolais 6T ewes to £91 both from RJ Mitchell & LA Voke.

STOCK RAMS (36)

A fast trade for the best quality rams with smart strong Blue Texel ram lambs topping at £250 and £215 from Eastbury Livestock. Cracking Charollais rams equally sought also to £250 twice from S Fry with powerful Charollais x Suffolk 4T rams wanted to £175 from J Davis. Several lesser quality and older rams presented today were more difficult to place in comparison.

EWE LAMBS (85)

A mixed quality entry met plenty of interest with North Country Mule types topping at £77 and £76.50 from Padfield & Dyke. Smart Texel x ewe lambs wanted to £72.50 from Dave and Katie Mayo. Medium Texel types to £68 from Rainbow Wood Farm Partners.

STORE LAMBS (593)

A strong competitive trade from start to finish with all grades looking well sold. The few bigger framed lambs topped at £63.50 and £61.50 from S & M Jones with others to £61 and £60 from Jamies Farm, £61 from TJ Blewett and £60 from V & H Christopher. Plenty of medium framed lambs met a large complement of potential purchasers with prices regularly from £50 to £59. The smaller long term types also sold well with almost all settling in advance of £40.
