HEREFORDS (72)

As with the rest of today's cattle the Herefords created excellent prices throughout the sale. Not too many younger steers & heifers available but for those forward prices regularly between £750 and £800 with the best to £860 from PG Lambert & Son. Yearling heifers with bulling potential from the same home equally sought from £748 and topped at £750 for B Rose & Son and AT Petty. Only a few framed steers on offer and sold to £1020 from High House Farm Ltd. Bulling heifers again wanted and sold from £815 from High House Farm Ltd, £822 for LP Norman & Sons to £875 from Richard & Emma Foot. Larger framed types from £900 from B Rose & Son to £915 from John, Ray and Russell Cock.

ANGUS (206)

A good show of turnout cattle met another fast trade with named sires and farm assurance at a premium. Dairy bred yearlings a cracking trade with Andy Neills steers to £730, J & P Griffins to £732 and Winston Heals to £748. Suckler bred yearlings an outstanding trade with well grown types to £898 from WW Hannam & Sons. Medium framed turnout steers sold well with dairy crosses from £938 to £1020 from Graham White and £940 from Richard & Emma Foot. Fleshed steers with potential in short supply except for LP Normans Angus to £1052. Heifers also met a flying trade with bulling potential yearlings wanted and regularly selling from £718 to £795 with Graham Whites to £915. Fleshed heifers in demand to £935 from FF & J Down to £980 from Floyd Butcher topping at £1015 from Richard & Emma Foot.

FRIESIANS (129)

Over 100 on offer met a sensational trade with all grades selling to advantage. Vendors are encouraged to sell early to maximise returns. Forward steers wanted and regularly sold over £800 with quality consignments from Tony Rich selling from £818 to £850 and super weights from £960 for John Gardner to £1000 from RJ Foot. Turn out Holstein Friesians with average frames regularly sold from £755 to £795 with strong British types selling to £842 for DA & AKJ Withers to £860 from DL Clark Partnership. Younger steers also an amazing trade from £550 to £672. Well done to all for presenting a better show this week.

Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
