SUCKLER CATTLE

A few small consignments forward this week met a brisk demand with good Limousin cows and Blue heifer calves to £1680 from RJ & PJ Northover. Limousin cows with Angus steer calves at foot to £990 from GP Spiller with his Continental outfits from £930 to £950. Pedigree Simmental bull ready to work wanted to £1240 from KJ Hickery.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another good show of young Continentals with the well presented suckled types commanding the greatest interest. **STEERS:** An exceptional Charolais from Smith Farms topped at a massive £1200. Cracking Blondes from ST Poulson set the trade topping at £1078 with smart Limousins closely following at £1050 from T Bravin. A consignment of Simmentals from HJ & DAM Marklove sold well from £945 to £1000 with other nice Simmentals to £885 from PF Best & Son. The handful of Blues on offer were well sold to £950 from Filer & Miller Ltd and £900 from Pittard Partners. Generally the dairy bred steers settled in advance of £700 and more would have sold well on this trade.

HEIFERS: Limousins were keenly contested to £840 from T Bravin with Blondes closely following at £830 from JJ Taylor & Son. Nice Blues from Pittard Partners were wanted to £825 with younger dairy bred sorts to £620 from Milton Westcombe Farms. Overall another good trade with vendors well rewarded for marketing their stock.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.

ANGUS (178)

The Angus cattle once again continue to command a premium particularly those with a named sire and from a farm assured holding. Yearling steers peaked at £940 from JJ Taylor & Son with others keenly contested to £898 from KI Brown, £815 from RJ & PJ Northover and £810 from A Rackham. Plenty of even younger sorts sold very well from £700 to £755 (8mo) from Mike Lovell and £745 from R Taylor & Son (7mo). Yearling Angus heifers met an equally fast trade peaking at £890 again from JJ Taylor & Son. Most met a brisk demand from £600 with well presented types to £685 from KI Brown and £650 from Richard and Robert Hole. The forward cattle met another exceptional trade with the quality framed types sparking very brisk bidding. Steers from Derek and Marion Legg topped at £1328 with others easily over £1200 to £1275 from Alan and Ian Farwell and £1260 from Wallmead Farms Partnership. Plenty of steers with shape and conformation sold in advance of the £1000 mark to £1192 from Roger Froud, £1180 from RJ Mead, £1122 from Peter and Roger Seare and £1085 from GH Elliott & Co. All these vendors were well rewarded for presented such quality cattle. The run of forward heifers met an equally cracking trade with smart types from Roger and Peter Seare peaking at £1115. Others easily to £1088 from Roger Froud and £1055 from Filer & Miller Ltd. Plenty of well presented heifers with bulling potential sold from £800 to £890 from LP Norman & Sons, £890 from JJ Taylor & Son and £820 from G Bown & Son. Many more would have sold very well of this flying trade.

HEREFORDS / DEVONS (65)

Not too many younger Herefords on offer this week but those forward met a good demand. Named sire steers (14-15mo) wanted to £755 from Filer & Miller Ltd and £750 from Norman Barnes. Very young Devon steers (only 6mo) from Polly Whetham met a strong trade selling to £530 with their yearling types to £675. Yearling heifers were scarce with today's selection topping at £755 from Tom Bravin. Others generally from £500 to £545 from RE & D Woodward for dairy bred types. The stronger cattle met a flying demand with steers soaring over £1200 peaking at £1240 from Fiona Burkeman and £1235 from P Ogborne. Not so many forward heifers on offer this week with nice types to £972 from LP Norman & Sons and £900 from RH & CM Johnston. More well fleshed types would have sold to advantage.

FRIESIANS (136)

A small but useful entry of Friesians this week with the younger types sparking keen interest. Yearling steers were keenly contested to £665 from G Bown & Son and more of these quality sorts would have sold to advantage. Another consignment from Harry Street met a brisk demand to £545. Others yearlings generally from £450. The stronger Friesian cattle topped at £920 from Alan and Ian Farwell with no framed finished sorts on offer to test the trade. Good types with potential wanted to £825 from Roger Froud and £785 from Graham and Rose Froud.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Another sensational trade for the forward Continentals this week with prices almost hitting the £1500 mark. A cracking consignment of steers from Smith Farms (Nigel and Tim Smith) was a particular highlight with their Blues to £1490, Limousins to £1400 and Blondes to £1320. Other top quality steers regularly sold in advance of £1000 with Blondes to £1252 from ST Poulson, Simmentals to £1205 from P Ogborne, Blues to £1160 from Freeman Bros and Charolais to £1138 from Derek and Marion Legg. The forward heifers were also in demand and more would have sold to a very competitive trade. Blues from Martin and Clive Snell topped at £1128 with Limousins to £1060 from JJ Taylor & Son and Blues to £1020 from Roger Froud. Well presented types with bulling potential sold well with Blues to £945 from RJ & PJ Northover and £842 from PG Curtis. Overall a fantastic trade which shows no sign on waning.
