**STEERS TO £1,200 HEIFERS TO £1,145**

A good entry of stores at Frome today with a better show of mainly younger cattle forward. The better quality in high demand selling well with less demand for younger and plainer sorts. Young suckler bred types equally well sold with some quality consignments competitively bid for.

### **SUCKLER COWS & CALVES**

More suckler cows & calves than first expected with a few late entries coming forward. Mainly older types on offer which saw trade generally £800 - £900. Super Limousin cows and top quality calves were wanted and a grand outfit from CP Groves sold to an excellent £1,400. Grazing cows to £780 - £880.

### **YOUNG CONTINENTALS**

A variable trade in this section and all revolved around the quality of those presented for sale. Good single suckled steers 10 - 12mo wanted. Smart Limousin steers 8mo from the Hares Partnership to £800. A number of quality Simmental steers and heifers were presented for sale and CR Ridout topped at £925 and RE Dury & Son to £788. David Glover produced a wonderful entry of mainly Simmental x steers and heifers which saw a lively trade to £850 for the younger types. Owen & Valerie Dibdin continuing to present their usual very high quality of stock. Their Limousin steers £945 and heifers £820. Generally a few less heifer buyers forward this week but all buyers being cautious as the feed concentrates are currently at high levels. Dairy x Continentals seeing a firm trade but several cattle still showing effects of the very dry summer.

### **ABERDEEN ANGUS**

High demand for well grown and presented Angus with Farm Assurance and named sires. Plenty of buyers in attendance however plainer sorts harder to sell due to the increasing cost and time of year. A cracking steer from Angus Neish topped the trade at £1200 followed by £1140 from DO Webb. Other forward steers with good frames and potential achieved £1080 from S & G Jenkins and £1035 from Townhill Farming Partnership. Good heifers from Townhill Farming achieved £1145 followed by £1028 from Angus Neish. Plainer, medium framed types and young farming cattle harder to place however good quality well-bred sorts selling well. A smart young steer from WO & V Dibdin reached a storming £952 for 13mo. Other young home-bred cattle from Richard Salter achieving £702 for 8mo. Younger heifers from Dave Carnell reached £785 for 13mo.

## HEREFORDS

A large entry of Hereford steers forward which experienced a better trade for the best. 5 smart Hereford steers from Lulworth Castle Farms topped at £1050, which was closely followed by a large steer from PW, CC & JC Gould at £1042. A cracking run of medium steers from Townhill Farming looked well sold at £900. Younger 10mo steers from N & S Glover to £720, with other younger types from CR Ridewood to £670. Hereford heifers enjoyed a better trade on the week, with better runs of cattle forward. Best Hereford heifer to £1080 from RJ Harraway. A smart bunch of bulling heifers from Townhill Farming enjoyed competitive bidding and selling at £900 who had others at £845 and £790. Younger 12 - 14mo heifers to £650 from J & CW Rawlings.

## FRIESIANS

A cracking run of Friesians forward today, which enjoyed competition throughout, with a strong steer from Richard McKie topping at £860. A lovely run of British Friesians from Mike & Bridget Cox of Bridgwater which received great interest and bidding, eventually selling at £850 with others to £810. A cracking run of younger Friesians 10 - 13mo from Richard McKie, enjoyed spirited bidding with best to £582, with others to £500 twice and £450.

## FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Mainly younger cattle forward which met a selective trade with buyers paying a premium for well-bred and reared types. Second grades at a discount due to higher fodder prices. Well reared Simmental steers met fast bidding with 18 - 19mo steers to £1100 from both David Glover and Derek & Graham Stevens. Their Charolais equally sought after to £1005. Quality bred Limousin met a competitive trade with non - Fabbl forward steers from £1010, £1040 to £1055 all from C Raymond. Several consignments of feeding steers sold between £880 to £965. Heifers sold to a strong demand with shapey, younger Limousin heifers to £945 and forward types to £1048 from Paul Hurd. Younger Simmental heifers met a firm trade from £830 from PW, CC & JC Gould, £858 from S & G Jenkins, £895 from Derek & Graham Stevens to top at £920 from David Glover. Good conformation British Blue heifers sold well from £895 from Derek & Graham Stevens to £940 from PW, CC & JC Gould. Overall second grades showing signs of the dry summer.
