SUCKLER COWS

North Devon in calf breeding cows sold well to £960 but only a limited number on offer. Breeding bulls also scarce today but plenty of demand and nice types from Natural England saw their Pedigree Angus to £1560.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

The entries coming through at this time of year are seeing big variation in quality. Demand strong for the better types and more could have been sold to advantage. Super single suckled Simmental and Limousin steers from RE Dury & Son, 8 - 9 month created furious bidding to £840 - £865. Hard coated Simmental steers from Chris Rose sold well to £720. Dairy bred Continentals were generally younger types with some nice runs of weaned calves all of which sold well. More best sorts were needed today.

HEREFORDS

A tremendous entry of Herefords today with a fleshy forward steer from Bryan Read Ltd topped at £1230, with others from C & L Farming at £1090. Younger Hereford steers from ML & RI Loder to £1055. Two quality 13 month steers from CT Knot eventually sold at £805. No older heifers forward today however the younger sorts were wanted with a 15 mo heifer eventually achieving £740. Some quality Native cattle forward today with three cracking Lincoln cattle selling at £1150 from TA Davis. A smart 18 month beef Shorthorn heifer topped at £978.

ABERDEEN ANGUS

A flying trade for all types of Angus kept firm by high demand from many buyers looking to fill orders. The best pen of steers topped the day at £1300 from Rob Bartlett of Ridgeway Farms followed closely by £1295 from M McManus. Other quality forwards from Crocker Moor Farm and Spicer Partners to £1190 and £1160 respectively. Forward heifers from TA Davis saw bidding to £1195 followed by £1150 from Ridgeway Farms. Butchers types regularly above £900. Smart young steers from Lockerly Hall to £730 for 11 months and £798 for 12 months.

FRIESIANS

A cracking trade for all types of Friesians consigned influenced by the recent grass growth and farm beef price. Heavy fleshed Friesians from Bryan Read sparked bidding pushing prices to £1142. Forward Friesians from the Spicer Partners with large frames and potential to finish well to £878. Another good pen of forward Friesians from Maurice and Rupert Loder to £822. A consignment of farming type Friesian steers from Harry Street sold to strong demand reaching £650 with younger steers from Mark and Lucy Doggrell to £520. Other Dairy breeds sold well, a good consignment of Fleckvieh steers from HJ Moody achieved £1160 with well fleshed Montbellaire steers to £1140 from Bryan Read.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A much sharper trade today as beef is starting to get short. Fierce bidding for a quality Limousin steer from TA Davis, which eventually sold to £1288. Other cracking Limousin steers from Crocker Moor Farm topped at £1190. A cracking run of Simmental steers also from Crocker Moor Farm topped at £1152. Younger Charolais steers topped at £1070 from T & J Crees. Quality British Blues from Crocker Moor Farm again, topped at £1192. Meaty forward heifers were wanted today with the best British Blue heifer achieving £1202 from GB & GM Stafford. Other strong Blues from KF Romain achieved £1070 and £1040. Limousin heifers met fast bidding with a cracking pair of heifers from TA Davis of Clapton achieved £1098.
