An exceptional Autumn trade! Now harvest has finished buyers have come to market in force looking to replenish stock with the trade set to continue over the coming months.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

A phenomenal demand for the young Continentals this week with the best steers soaring over £1000. Blues peaked at £1025 from Ingsdon Farm. Charolais equally sought also to £1025 from Will Stitch. Others good well presented steers easily sold in advance of £750 with Simmentals just shy of the £900 mark from Colin Pople and Charolais to £880 from Stuart and Lorna King. Heifers generally a little more scarce with smart suckled Blues from Steve North topping at £800 with Limousins to £765 from Hares Partnership. The dairy bred cattle also sold to a brisk demand and more of all breeds and grades would have sold to advantage.

ANGUS / HEREFORDS

The **Angus** cattle met a fantastic demand with some exceptional pure bred steers (only 20mo) from Angus Neish topped at a massive £1335 with his others easily to £1218. Other well presented forward steers sparked brisk bidding to £1130 from JM & PJ Evans, £1090 from Roger Martin and Graham Few, £1038 from Cartwright Hignett Partners and £1020 from Colin Pople. Forward heifers equally sought topping at £1198 from JM & PJ Evans and £1120 from BW Ewins & Partners. Medium farming steers wanted from £750 to £850 with bulling heifers generally from £700 to £800. Yearling steers topped at a cracking £958 from JJ Taylor & Son with others to £935 from MR Meredith and £922 from RE Long & Son. Similar aged heifers more scarce but wanted to £712 again from MR Meredith with others to £640 from WA Salvidge & Son and £640 from RE Long & Son. Plenty more would have sold to advantage. Some well presented forward **Hereford** steers sparked keen interest to £1050 from DL & BM Gordge and £980 from Roger Martin & Graham Few. Yearling steers wanted to £820 from Colin Pople with others to £815 from Hares Partnership and £762 from RE Long & Son. Heifers not so plentiful this week with good medium farming sorts to £890 from SW Payne and £878 from LP Norman & Son. Yearling heifers generally from £600 to £650.

FRIESIANS

Friesians more scarce than of late with demand still firm for all ages. The best fleshed steers topped at £1050 from LW & RJ Wyatt and £960 from DM PM & AD Drake. Others with some strength to £900 from Will Stitch and £840 from DJ Butchers. Well presented Fleckveih topped at £1180 from DL & BM Gordge with Montbeliardes to £1000 from Will Stitch and MRIs to £900 again from DM & BM Gordge. Norwegian Reds to £895 from D & P Hawkins. Younger Friesians generally from £400 to £500.
