STEERS TO £1,300 HEIFERS TO £1,195

A better trade than anticipated with the younger cattle starting at a very brisk pace and the stronger fleshed types continuing to command keen interest.

SUCKLER CATTLE

A small but useful entry comprising Angus x first calved heifers with young named sire Angus calves at foot from DW Hewlett. These outfits with farming potential easily settled in advance of £900 with the best to £1080.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

A mixed quality entry met a brighter trade than expected with the good farming sorts sparking plenty of interest. A consignment of predominantly Simmentals from DJ Glover set the trade with his steers regularly from £950 peaking at £1075 and his heifers from £650 to £790. Strong Blue steers peaked at £880 from PG Snell & Sons with some nice young heifers to £570 from BJ Stainer & Son. Limousins from D Tomlins & N Bosley wanted with steers to £728 and heifers to £595. Most steers settled between £650 and £700 with heifers generally around the £600 mark. The harder leaner sorts perhaps met a slightly more variable demand but still sold well for their type.

ANGUS (153)

The Angus cattle continue to spark interest with the named sire and farm assured cattle particularly wanted. Cracking slightly older steers (15mo) from JE Cock & Son sold very well to £1135 and £1015. Yearling steers generally settled in advance of £650 with nice types to £850 from R & R Kirby and £795 from Arminca Ltd. Yearling heifers peaked at £725 from PG Snell & Sons with others to £705 from R & R Kirby. Other heifers generally from £550 to £590 from DF & BA Wheeler. The stronger Angus cattle met a flying trade with the best soaring over £1200. Fleshed steers peaked at £1295 from G Read & Son, £1290 from DJ Glover, £1195 from JM & PJ Evans, £1185 from RC Few & Sons and £1180 from Lulworth Castle Farms. Plenty more settled over £1100 from RA Edwards & Son, JE Cock & Son, RM Fear and PG Snell & Sons. The forward heifers also met a brisk trade but were more few and far between. Fleshed types peaked at £1000 from RC Few & Sons with others to £995 from WL Baxandall and £940 from DF & BA Wheeler.

HEREFORDS / DEVONS (76)

Not so many younger Herefords on offer this week but those forward met a firm demand. Named sire yearling steers topped at £852 from R & R Kirby with others from the same consignment easily to £790. Heifers from the same home wanted to £800. Other young heifers settled around the £600 mark. Very few forward cattle as well this week with nice framed steers to £1080 from Lulworth Castle Farms with others to £1045 from RC Few & Sons and £1035 from GRB Boyes. Older heifers peaked at £950 from DF & BA Wheeler and many more would have sold to a good trade. Nice fleshed Devons steers from RM Fear sold well to £990.

FRIESIANS (182)

A few more younger Friesians forward this week which generally met an improved trade. A run from DA Bower set a good trade with good sorts from £475 to £520. Other young sorts with potential to £510 (only 7mo) from Read Farming. No strong forward steers on offer this week but the medium farming types met a firm demand to £865 from AM & RS Rich. Others to £790 from P Denning & Son. Normande steers (18mo) sold to £815 from Frost & Frost.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A cracking run of forward Continentals this week with a large entry of steers regularly selling in advance of £1000. An unusual entry of Parthenaise from JE Cock & Son topped the day with his steer

at £1300 and his heifer at £1195. Quality Blue steers peaked at £1235 from EL Norris & Son with others wanted to £1200 from PG Apsey and £1170 for younger sorts (17mo) from BJ Stainer. Well presented Limousin steers sold well to £1165 from DJ Glover whose Blondes were keenly contested to £1095 and Simmentals to £1075. Other quality Continental steers from RM Fear sparked brisk bidding with his Charolais to £1150 and Limousins to £1085 RM Fear. Heifers were more scarce with the few best sorts wanted. Charolais peaked at £1155 from WL Baxandall and Simmentals at £1150 from BK & A Garrett & Son. The younger farming heifers with bulling potential generally settled between £750 and £800.
