YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Some good runs of young Continentals this week with more on offer to spark a competitive trade. A cracking consignment of home bred single suckled Blue steers from RJ Bull set the trade easily selling from £860 to £918. Quality Limousin from Oliver Hares wanted to £885 with Charolais to £840 from Cutteridge Farm and Simmentals to £802 from Jim & James Mcilwain. Heifers were more scarce with the well presented farming types sparking a brisk demand. Limousins topped at £745 from Oliver Hares with Charolais to £705 from Cutteridge Farm and Blues to £688 from Chris Love. More of all breeds in high demand.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.

HEREFORDS

Not too many younger Herefords presented today but those forward met a marvellous demand. A well presented run of steers (7mo) from MW & LJ Baker peaked at £585 with others from the same home regularly from £520. Young heifers very scarce and generally settling around the £480 mark. The stronger Hereford cattle met a buoyant trade with framed types to £1085 from Robert Gulliford and £1018 from RW & HC Breach. Other good farming steers wanted from £905 from Dave Flux to £1000 from T & J Crees. No forward heifers on offer with the medium farming types trading around the £680 mark.

ANGUS

The named sire and farm assured Angus continue to command keen interest with yearling steers wanted to £845 from David and Barbara Wheeler and £845 also from Margaret Meredith & family. Other useful steers regularly from £650 to £792 from Mickey Lovell and £745 from JM Behegan. Yearling heifers in short supply topping at £662 from David and Barbara Wheeler. Other heifers with potential generally ranged from £580 to £605 from Malcolm and Sharyn White and £595 again from Mickey Lovell. The forward cattle met a flying trade with fleshed steers to a massive £1285 from Charlie Butcher. Other well presented strong steers easily to £1100 from Margaret Meredith & family, £1095 from Will Stitch and £1000 from PW Townsend & Partners. Other good farming types wanted from £935 from C Thompson & Son to £985 from T & J Crees. Forward heifers again from Charlie Butcher topped at £1185 with others from the same home to £1130 and £1085. Good bulling types keenly contested to £925 from WS Stitch, £900 from RW & HC Breach and £860 from Oliver Hares.

FRIESIANS

Another consignment of young Friesian calves (4-5mo) from Green Lane Farming met a solid trade to £275 with well presented Fleckveih (4mo) from the same home to £445. Stronger yearling Friesian steers met a fair trade to £470 from David and Barbara Wheeler and £468 from Malcolm and Sharyn White. Good medium types with farming potential sold to a good complement of purchasers. The best today topped at £898 from Margaret Meredith & family with others to £838 from Dave Flux.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Some quality runs of forward Continental cattle today with the best soaring over the £1100 mark. Cracking Blue and Simmental steers from Steve and Joe Spicer topped at £1240 and £1195. The best Limousin steers were keenly contested to £1238 from Paul Hurd and £1100 from Will Stitch. A well presented consignment of Blues from RW & HC Bulkington sparked brisk bidding with their steers to £1078 and their heifers from £1025 to £1035. Simmental and Limousin heifers from the same home sold very well both to £1095.
