## ORGANICS

Fewer Organics consigned due to the time of year with all sold to a fair trade despite the drop in beef price and poor grass situation. Cows and calves from Coverleaf Ltd to £1100 for an Angus cow with her 22 day old steer calf with a Sire. A quality consignment of pure bred Simmentals from CW Gould saw 12mo heifers to £895. A good consignment of well bred Herefords from Edward Lippiatt sparked competitive bidding with 13mo steers to £890 and heifers the same age to £750.

## COWS & CALVES, BULLS

Demand ahead of supply with a good selection of Angus cows with 1mo calves at foot selling to £1100 from Mr Pegler. The well bred Angus stock bull from Richard Miller & family met a competitive trade at £1600.

## YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Contrary to expectation the trade for the best quality single suckled Continental steers and heifers was very strong. Top sorts from MD James Chippenham, and Richard Dury Compton Martin, saw their Charolais and Simmental x steers and heifers 8-10mo £875 and £825 respectively. Wonderful Charolais and Simmental steers and heifers single suckled, home bred from MJ & NM Coombe 14-15mo were sold at top levels, steers to £1030 and heifers to £920. Overall it was the best cattle which held the trade. Plainer Dairy x Continentals much harder work and purely due to the lack of grass at the present time.

## HEREFORDS & ABERDEEN ANGUS

Fewer Angus consigned this week than previous. Angus with named sires still in demand from a number of buyers despite the poor grass situation. A quality consignment of well grown Angus from Steve Alvis and family topped the trade at £1150, £1130 and £1055. Other forward steers from CV Salmon to £1010. Larger framed butchers type heifers to £942 from Maurice & Rupert Loder and £920 from CV Salmon. Medium framed steers from PH Creed & Son to £790. A smaller number of Herefords consigned this week topped at £1085 from Phillip Stranger and family. Well grown types from Bill & Valerie Masters to £1038.

## FRIESIANS

More Friesians forward, which enjoyed a similar trade as previous weeks. A nice run from Hollands Farms Ltd enjoyed spirited bidding and eventually sold at £818 with others to £815. Some nice medium British Friesians from JR & DC Wolfe looked well sold at £750 with medium Holstein Friesian grazing steers from PA & RJ Stranger & Sons, with a strong run from SH & RS Weeden to £685.

## FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Competitive bidding for the 18-22mo cattle on offer with quality consignments from numerous vendors sold to a competitive trade. Well bred steers regularly over £1000 with fleshed Blondes the highlight to £1195 from Bill & Valerie Masters, similar Limousins sold to £1150 from Steve Alvis and younger steers to £1130 from Phillip Stranger & family. Other quality Limousins sold to £1095 from Steve Alvis and £1050 from John Wareham. Charolais met a fast trade with quality young steers to £1030 from Rockie Coombe and her Simmentals also to £1030. Other Simmentals sold to £1002 from Ingsdon Farm Ltd. Turn out steers wanted with Limousins from £922 to £935 from Steve Weeden. Another good selection of turn out heifers on offer with British Blue heifers from £918 from Phillip Stranger & family to £998 from Ingsdon Farm Ltd. Young British Blue heifers, with bulling potential, regularly sold over £800 with quality consignments from Robert, Ann & Jane Mayo selling to £858, Phillip Stranger & family to £878, John Wareham to £882 and Ingsdon Farm Ltd to £885. Similar Simmental heifers sold from £870 from Steve Weeden, £885 from Steve Alvis and £920 from Rockie Coombe.
