### SUCKLER CATTLE

A small entry met a brisk demand with Simmental x cows with Blue calves at foot wanted to £1370 from RJ & PJ Northover. Next Special Sale: Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> August @ 12 noon.

### YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another quality run of young Continentals this week met a flying trade and more would have sold to advantage. Cracking steers from J Wareham were a highlight with his Blues topping at £1125 and Limousins at £1050. Other well presented steers keenly contested with Simmentals to £875 from RA Barton with heifers from the same home to £758. Generally heifers were more scarce than of late with nice Blondes topping at £770 from C & L Farming. Young Limousins (8mo) sold well to £640 from Dave Hunt.

### ANGUS / HERE / FRIESIAN

The named sire and farm assured **Angus** continue to spark very keen interest and settle at very strong levels. Young steers wanted to £960 from J Wareham with others to £825 from RM Seare & Son, £770 from Andy Neill and £768 from Stock Estate Partnership. Yearling heifers equally sought to £780 again from RM Seare & Son with the handful of others to £708 from Freeman Bros. The stronger Angus sold very well with steers peaking at a massive £1348 from RH & CM Johnston. Others easily to £1230 from G Read & Son, £1215 from DH Wilkinson & Sons and £1155 from RM Seare & Son. Forward heifers more scarce but wanted to £1042 from Stock Estate Partnership with younger sorts to £985 from RM Seare & Son and £960 from AH Farming. The younger **Hereford** cattle were more few and far between than of late but those on offer still commanded brisk bidding. Steers (14mo) peaked at £800 from J Wareham with others generally from £700 to £740 from B & P White, £730 from J & S Farming and £730 also from RW Kevern. Yearling heifers sold very well peaking at £848 again from J Wareham and more would have sold to advantage. The handful of stronger cattle sparked brisk bidding with steers to £1180 from EN RG & MJ Ractliffe and £1170 from RI Geddes & Partners. Heifers from the same home peaked at £1080. More would have sold to advantage. A solid trade once again from the **Friesian** cattle today with another consignment of yearling steers from C & F Street Partnership topping at £675. Other younger types (10mo) settled at £505 from CD Griffin Partners and £495 from GA Durston & Son. Well fleshed Friesians met a flying trade to top at £1015 from GP Spiller. Medium farming sorts wanted to £930 from RI Geddes & Partners and £880 from RM Seare & Son. Montbeliardes to £1040 from Virgin & Sons.

### FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A small but strong entry of forward Continentals met a blistering trade with Blue steers topping at £1315 from EN RG & MJ Ractliffe. Other quality Blue steers keenly contested to £1285 from RI Geddes & Partners and £1135 from WP Harrison. The handful of other stronger steers sold well with Simmentals to £1120 from J Trott & Sons and Blondes to £1100 from C & L Farming. A shortage of forward heifers met a flying trade with Blues to £1100 from RI Geddes & Partners.
