**ANGUS**

A rocketing trade for all Angus cattle and buyers were hungry for both suckled and dairy x types with not enough on offer to fill order books. Younger steers (10-14mo) saw prices over £780 with the best peaking at £880. Younger heifers were in short supply but those on offer commanded lively bidding. More forward steers and heifers were met with some blistering prices with an outstanding consignment of cattle from Rupert Nuttall & Partners seeing his steers to £1430, £1415, £1255 and £1185 with Heifers from the same home to £1272. Overall a truly outstanding day in this ring!

**HEREFORDS**

Well presented consignments of Herefords sold to a flying trade on both the forward and younger types. Bidding for the best steers finished at £1245 for George Wareham & Son with other forward steers above £1000. Medium steers between £738 & £885 with younger steers (14mo) from Reg Cook reaching £860. Heifers well bid for with medium sorts to £750 from PR Hill.

## FRIESIANS

All Friesians were in strong demand throughout the sale topping at £1130 for a cracking steer from George Wareham & Son with other large framed forward steers to £885 from A Bown. Younger steers still in demand as grass continues to grow reaching £600 from D & P Hawkins.

## FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A marvellous trade for forward continentals reflecting the current buoyancy in finished prices. A fantastic entry of well presented cattle were well bid for with a cracking consignment from George Wareham & Son seeing his steers average at £1294. Limousin steers from this consignment topped the trade selling at £1475 with smart Limousin steers from Rupert Nuttall & Partners to £1300. Blue steers from George Wareham to £1435 with other quality types from Roy & Russell Cock reaching £1245. Simmental steers to £1305 again from George Wareham & Son with the Charolais section topped at £1210 from Roy & Russell Cock and their heifers equally sought to £1210. Blues from Ingsdon Farm Ltd reached £1155 with other consignments of quality heifers regularly above £1000.

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

**If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.**

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
