COWS WITH CALVES

A smart consignment of Limousin outfits from D & R Miller & Son met an excellent trade. Their Limousin cows with heifer calves at foot peaked at £1160 with others easily to £1060.

FEEDING BULLS

Young bulls sparked brisk bidding with Herefords (10mo) to £535 from S Branch. Stronger Herefords to £912. Friesians (5mo) to £395 from High House Farm Ltd.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

A tremendous trade with plenty of quality types on offer to spark keen interest. The first annual consignment from the Phillips family (Kingsdown Farm Ltd) were a highlight. Their well reared and presented Charolais x steers (10mo) regularly sold in advance of £890 peaking at £908 and their Simmental steers (11mo) ranged from £812 to £878. Their suckled Charolais and Simmental heifers (10mo) were equally sought from £755 to £792. There were plenty of other quality cattle forward with outstanding Charolais steers from Sarah Jackson topping at £1002. Dairy bred Blues from DIVA (Sherborne) Ltd sold well to £788. Most suckled sorts all topped the £700 mark and more would have sold to advantage.

BEEF SCHEMES – NAMED SIRES

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.

ANGUS (149)

Named sired and farm assured Angus continue to command a premium with all ages in demand. Young steers and heifers met a firm demand with the best to £770 from AK Apsey & Son and £645 from BJ Singleton & Sons respectively. Plenty sold in advance of £600 with steers from Kingsdown Farm Ltd settling over the £700 mark. Medium feeding sorts generally settled around £750 with nice outlying steers to £828 from D Mouland. The stronger cattle sparked brisk bidding with steers to £1078 from WCG Simmons, £1075 from the Late R Lock, £1042 from SR Stuckey & Sons and £1000 from RJ Adams. Fleshed heifers equally sought to £1050 from MJ & CR Adams, £990 from RJ Adams and £990 from D Hood.

HEREFORD (63)

Some quality consignments on offer this week with the best well bred steers topping at £1100 from both A Robbins and the Late R Lock. Others keenly sought to £1090 from S Branch and £990 from Green Lanes Farming. Forward heifers more scarce but those forward sold well to £1025 again from Green Lanes Farming. Younger sorts wanted with well bred steers to £780 from both D & R Miller & Son and A Robbins. Yearling heifers settled in advance of £500 with nice types to £558 from DIVA (Sherborne) Ltd.

FRIESIANS (86)

Another good run of Friesians this week with demand firm throughout. No young steers on offer this week but the medium sorts with farming potential generally settled from £650 to £718 from SR Stuckey & Sons. The stronger cattle peaked at £950 again from SR Stuckey & Sons with others to £890 from C & R Padfield and £860 from DO Webb. The plainer steers also sold well.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

The Phillip family also set the trade in the forward Continental section with their cracking Charolais steers (19mo) to £1160 with heifers to £950. Well fleshed quality Blues from AJ Langley & Son sold very well to £1168 with smart heifers to £1125 from HT Farthing. Nice Limousin steers from the Sprake family topped at £1150 with others to £1070 from A Robbins, £1065 from the Late R Lock and £1035 from Andrew & Lucy Frizzle. Forward Simmental and Limousin heifers both wanted to £1035 from HT Farthing. Blonde steers from PL & S Potter sparked brisk bidding to £1030.
