SUCKLER CATTLE

A small but good quality entry met a brisk demand with some nice young Angus cows with Limousin steer calves at foot to £1340 from Stowford Manor Farm. In-calf Limousin heifers from J Creed & S Doyle peaked at £1050. Pedigree Hereford bulls to £1140 from BM Heal & Sons.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another buoyant trade for the young Continentals this week with the well presented single suckled types in particular sparking brisk bidding. A quality entry of Simmentals from DAM & HJ Marklove sold well with their steers topping at £1100 and heifers at £750. Other Simmental steers topped the £1000 mark from North Dairy Farm. A wonderful consignment of Limousins from PJ & A Boulton met a brisk trade with their steers to £965 and heifers to £755. Nice Charolais steers from Lockerley Hall Farm wanted to £940 with Charlie Butcher's to £950. The dairy bred cattle also met a firm trade and more would have sold to advantage.

ANGUS

Some nice younger cattle on offer this week with the named sire types sparking the most interest. A cracking consignment from SCJ Hole met a fast demand with their steers (11-14mo) regularly from £800 to £948 with their heifers easily from £700 to £750. Other nice steers easily to £900 from Lockerley Hall Farm, £895 from BL Tayler & Partners and £895 also from MW Norman & Son. Other yearling heifers a little more scarce to £670 from MW Norman & Son and £668 from Ipley Manor Farm. The stronger Angus cattle met another flying demand with steers regularly over £1000. Cracking steers from I Watson topped the day at £1182 with others closely following at £1175 from MW Norman & Son. Forward heifers topped at £1020 from RW & HC Breach with bulling sorts settling around the £800.

HEREFORDS

Young steers wanted to £895 from SCJ Hole with others from the same home easily to £890 and £845. Other good steers (15mo) to £850 from Norridge Farms. Yearling heifers also from SCJ Hole sold well to £735, £730 and £715. The forward cattle sold well today with farmed steers easily to £1100 from AG & RV Rossiter and £1050 from J & WR Adams. Only a handful of stronger heifers this week with the best to £918 from AR Jones. Younger types with bulling potential from £700 to £780 from GD Goddard.

FRIESIANS

Not quite so many forward this week but all grades and ages met a firm demand. The medium to cattle with farming potential topped at £855 from Paul Hurd with smaller sorts to £688 from BW & GJ Gray. Yearling Friesians peaked at £502 from TCF (Wiltshire) Ltd with others to £500 from IA Smith.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Another fantastic trade for the forward Continentals with prices once again soaring past the £1100 on numerous occasions. **STEERS:** A cracking run of cattle from Charlie Butcher sold very well with the Charolais to £1290, Blues to £1240 and Simmentals to £1160. Other framed Blues wanted to £1160 from AJ Grabham & Son and £1135 from Ingsdon Farm. Limousins also topped the £1000 mark to £1080 from both Ingsdon Farm and North Dairy Farm. Other good steers with farming potential regularly from £850. **HEIFERS:** Not so many on offer this week but those forward met a brisk trade. Quality Blues again from Charlie Butcher topped at £1085 with Charolais from the same home easily to £1082. Other good heifers with bulling potential generally traded in advance of £750 with Simmentals to £900 from both I Watson and PW CC & JC Gould.

Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
