ORGANIC CATTLE (305)



An unprecedented entry in terms of numbers forward with trade vibrant from start to finish. A well presented consignment of Devon and Shorthorns from Peckons Hill Farms set the trade with their steers topping at £1200, £1090 and £1040 whilst their heifers peaked at £995. Named sire Hereford steers from Chave & Foster topped at £998 followed by Daniell & Hole's at £890 with Blues from the same home to £872. A large consignment of 128 Charolais from regular supporters Sargent & Waight were very keenly contested with their Charolais steers (11mo) to £870 with younger types (7mo) easily to £785. Heifers (7mo) from the same home attracting strong competition to peak at £780. Well reared Continentals and Angus (7mo) from Gore Farm Partnership met an equally good trade with their best steers to £800 and heifers to £680. YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another sensational trade the young Continental cattle today with plenty of quality suckled consignments attracting a large complement of buyers. A particular highlight was the home bred single suckled consignment of 165 Limousins (5-7mo) from FC Cottle & Son. These well presented and reared calves were readily sold with his best pens of steers to £930 with others to £920, £860 and £850. Over 50 steers sold in advance of £800 with over 50 heifers selling in excess of £670. Their smartest pen of heifers peaked at £758, £730 and £720. Additional suckled consignments that attracted plenty of interest included Limousin steers from MA Campbell Hill to £765 and £700 from Claire Baber plus Simmental steers to £735 from MG Miller. Cracking Charolais steers from Alan Coffin topped at a massive £1080 with much younger suckled calves to £860 from FC Cottle & Son and £825 from Marks Cattle. Smart Blue steers from C & W Hannam & Son keenly contested to £950 with their heifers equally sought to £805. All the smart suckled calves met a fantastic trade with vendors well rewarded for presented such quality sorts. The dairy bred cattle perhaps met a slightly easier demand but still sold well for their type.

ANGUS

The named sire and farm assured Angus continue to spark plenty of interest with some well presented consignments forward this week. The best young steers today topped at £865 from LP Norman & Sons with heifers from N Webb to £665. The annual consignment from LJ Frampton & Son met a fantastic trade with their steers (6-7mo) regularly from £770 to top at £850 and £835. Their smart little heifers peaked at 630 with other pens easily to £630 and £600. Other nice shapely young steers sold to £800 from JB Carter. Plenty of forward Angus this week met a buoyant trade with the best steers to £1155 from Rossiter & Son. Other well fleshed steers to £1055 from Townhill Farming Partnership, £1020 from EG Hedges & Son and £1000 from Roger Few & family. A smart entry of steers from H Caines & Son met plenty on interest topping at £995. Farming steers wanted to £955 from NG Tucker & Sons and £900 from F Drake. The forward heifers met a flying trade toping at 1105 from Townhill Farming Partnership, £1095 from Rossiter & Son and £1052 from Lockerley Hall Farm. Medium types with bulling potential generally from £800 to £858 from EG Hedges & Son.

HEREFORDS

The Hereford trade remains bright this week with more wanted to satisfy demand. The best yearling steers today topped at £888 and £885 from Tom Bravin with others to £748 from LP Norman & Sons and £700 from PJ Wood. Young heifers more scarce with LP Norman & Sons best pen to £685. Much younger heifers (8mo) with potential settled at £400 from Filer & Miller. Some smart stronger cattle this week with a consignment of steers from Townhill Farming Partnership regularly from £1000 peaking at £1082. Lighter heifers from the same home topped at £860.

FRIESIANS

Not too many yearling Friesians presented this week whilst the large runs of suckled calves are forward for sale. Holstein types (9mo) from Townsend Farming achieved £400. The stronger Friesian cattle met a firm demand once again with framed types to £905, £875 and £850 from Lodge Farm. Others with farming potential generally from £700 to £835 from GT Wareham & Son.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Another very brisk trade for the forward Continentals with some well presented quality types on offer to satisfy today's large complement of purchasers. Cracking fleshed Simmental steers from GT Wareham topped at £1180 with others to £1070 from RA Barton. Simmental steers from PJ & PF Samways closely followed at £1000 with their heifers to £955. Framed Limousins from Alan Coffin were keenly contested with their steers to £1150, £1100 and £1078 closely followed by Ian Hale's at £1105 and £1060. Limousin heifers with bulling potential also from Ian Hale wanted to £935 with plenty from £800 to £890. Cracking run of Blue steers from D & PR Tibbs & Son topped at £1145

with other fleshed types to £1120 from WT & JM Hill, £1080 from GT Wareham & Son and £1030 from PR & J Quick & Sons. Charolais again from Alan Coffin wanted to £1080 and £1040.
