YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Excellent prices once again for the younger Continentals with all grades keenly sought.

STEERS: Some cracking consignments of Simmentals this week topped at a massive £1120 from Lockerley Hall Farm. Others top sorts easily to £1115 from Kellaway & Prideaux, £1010 from KW & KN Greenslade and £985 from DE Bridger. Some smart Charolais closely followed peaked at £1040 from both KI Brown and D & GJ Stevens with others to £1035 from J Groves & Son. Other Continentals generally settled either side of the £800 mark with farming Blues to £835 from AJ Snook. The dairy bred types met good competition from £400 to £500. **HEIFERS:** Well presented Charolais heifers again from J Groves & Son topped at £905 with other quality types easily to £892 from D & GJ Stevens and £885 from KI Brown. Most heifers today met a brisk trade from £650 with good Blues to £788 from TFT & CA Handy and Limousins to £785 from GJ & SE Welch & Sons. Many more would have sold to advantage.

HEREFORDS (191)

A good run of yearling steers this week with the best to £845 from SR & CE Moorlen. Other well presented steers (11-13mo) easily from £750 to £840 from S Powell, £805 from JL & JL De Greeff and £800 from AG Wilmott & Son. Young heifers equally sought but not quite so plentiful with nice types to £755 from GJ & SE Welch & Sons. Most generally settled between £550 and £600 with the named sire cattle commanding the greatest interest. The well fleshed forward steers sold very well to £1078 from RI Geddes & Partners and £1020 from Virgin & Sons. Medium framed types with potential also in demand generally from £800 to £900. No strong forward heifers on offer this week but nice farming types peaked at £892 from SN Ellis & Son. Pedigree Hereford Bulls from Mrs J Groves & Son easily sold to £1280.

ANGUS (268)

An absolutely flying trade for the named sire Angus once again this week with quality yearling steers easily selling in advance of £900. Well presented types (13mo) peaked at £990 from KI Brown with others from the same home regularly from £950. Other nice steers keenly contested to £942 from Lockerley Hall Farm and £928 from MR Meredith. Yearling heifers met an equally buoyant trade to £852 from KI Brown. Most settled around the £600 mark with nice types to £748 from DE Bridger and £645 from BC & JM Rigler. A cracking consignment of forward steers and heifers from PJ Ross was a highlight and more of these quality sorts would have sold to advantage. Their best steers topped at £1268 with their heifers to £1060. Other quality steers regularly from £1000 to £1200 from O & J Hurd, £1165 from DI Crozier and £1150 from VL Vincent & Son. Other well fleshed heifers with named sires were keenly contested to £1025 from MW & BM Cox & Son and £970 from AP & JJ Williams.

FRIESIANS (99)

Not quite so many Friesians than of late but those on offer met a firm demand. Normande steers (13mo) topped at £588 from G Moore with Friesians (15mo) to £582 from RM & HM Heal. The stronger cattle met a firm trade with British types to £930 from O & J Hurd and I Watson. Medium sorts with farming potential wanted from £700 to £842 from P Hurd and £800 from DH Masters & Son.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

A flying trade once again for the forward Continentals and today's vendors were well rewarded. Plenty topped the £1000 and more would have sold to advantage. **STEERS:** Quality framed Blues from PJ Ross peaked at £1220 with others easily from £1100. A good show of Simmentals sparked very brisk competition closely following at £1210 from Kellaway & Prideaux, £1190 from AP & JJ Williams, £1152 from VL Vincent & Son and £1070 from I Watson. **HEIFERS:** Well fleshed Simmentals from AP & JJ Williams topped the heifer section at £1195 with Charolais to £1102 from O & J Hurd. Limousins easily to £1100 and Blues to £1020 both from PJ Ross. Several consignments of bulling heifers regularly sold from £830 to £982.

BEEF SCHEMES – NAMED SIRE

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
