A cracking entry from J & M King Brain were very keenly contested with their Limousin steers to £1380, Herefords to £1280 and Devons to £1245. Their Hereford heifers also sold very well peaking at £1180. Well presented Simmental steers from Daniell & Hole topped at £1340 with Angus from the same home to £1312. Framed Shorthorn steers wanted to £1145 from Pipplepen Farms. Another quality consignment of Pedigree and Pure Bred Simmental heifers from Charles and Janet Gould were a highlight topping at £1180 and £1175. Other smart Simmentals easily to £1095 from Daniell & Hole. Yearling Herefords met a sensational trade with Edward Lippiatt's Steers (12mo) topping at £992 and heifers at £975. YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Not quite so many young Continentals forward this week but those on offer met another flying demand. Cracking Charolais steers from Clive House topped at £990 and more of these well presented sorts would have sold to advantage. A nice consignment of Blues from K Graham & Partners sparked interest with their steers easily to £940 and their heifers to £785. Most steers generally sold in advance of £650 with nice suckled types with potential settling around the £750 mark. Heifers more scarce with nice suckled Limousins to £710 from Philliols Farm and Charolais to £750 from Boris and Sarah Chick.

BEEF SCHEMES: NAMED SIRES

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.

ANGUS

The named sire Angus cattle continue to command a premium and many more of all ages are wanted to satisfy demand. Yearling steers generally settled in advance of £700 with well presented types to £890 from AH Farming. Very young steers (6mo) sold well to £450 from TCF (Wiltshire) Ltd. Yearling heifers were few and far between with nice types to £760 again from AH Farming. Most traded around either side of the £600 mark and more with conformation and potential would have sold to advantage. The stronger Angus cattle were very keenly contested with well fleshed steers grossing over £1100 peaking at £1235 from CS & C Burgess. Other quality steers easily to £1190 from Arminca Ltd, £1185 from Roger Martin & Graham Few, £1178 from Andrew Groves and £1128 from Virgin & Sons. Plenty of other farming steers with potential settled in advance of £800. Not so many forward heifers this week but those on offer sold very well. Quality types from BC & PM Wallbridge topped at £1085 with others to the same prices from CS & C Burgess. Nice types from PW CC & JC Gould closely followed at £972 with others to £928 from Arthur and Greg Ridout and £880 from Clive House. Quality Devons steers to £1030 and heifers topping the day at £1090 both from FJ Moody.

HEREFORDS

The Hereford cattle met another brisk demand with the named sire and farm assured types particularly wanted. Very few younger Herefords on offer this week with steers to £720 and heifers to £605 from Philliols Farm. Steers (only 7mo) met a good trade to £670 from Clive House. The best forward steers topped at £1140 from Arthur & Greg Ridout and £1100 from BC & PM Wallbridge. Other well presented steers wanted to £1090 from Perrett & Son and £1080 from Virgin & Son. Very few forward heifers on offer with the best to £942 from BC & PM Wallbridge. More would have sold to a buoyant trade.

FRIESIANS

The Friesians continue to meet a steady demand with the stronger fleshed types meeting the best of the trade. The stronger Friesians sold very well topping at £1140 from Andrew Groves. Others wanted to £950 from BC & PM Wallbridge and £905 from EG PJ & RJ Cary. Nice types with potential from Longclose farm ranged from £842 to £858 with farming sorts to £820 from RS NJ & MP Glanville and £815 from LW & RJ Wyatt. A consignment of yearlings from CR Webber to £505.

Not so many strong forward Continentals compared to recent weeks but nevertheless trade was exceptional for those on offer. Cracking Simmental and Limousin steers from Andrew Groves were a highlight topping at £1370 and £1270 respectively. Quality Charolais steers from O & J Hurd topped at £1195 and smart Blues from BC & PM Wallbridge peaked at £1160. Limousin heifers topped at £1082 from Andrew Groves with Charolais to £1080 again from O & J Hurd. Well fleshed Simmentals wanted to £1000 from PW CC & JC Gould and Blues (17mo) to £1000 from WTD Bridzor. Many more of these quality types with good conformation would have sold to advantage.
