A typical end of June market with quite a variation in cattle presented. The few young single suckled Continentals were sold to premium levels. Claire Baber again presenting grand Limousin Steers & Heifers 6-8mo which saw prices to £895 & £725 respectively. PJ & A Boulton Pucklechurch continuing to enter superb Limousin single suckled Steers ranging £820-£950 and Heifers to an excellent £795. Quality British Blue Steers 12mo from BM Taylor £850-£890. Quality Dairy x Continentals from Wilverley Farms Lyndhurst had a cracking trade at £830 and Heifers a blistering £842. Excellent consignments of well reared Dairy x Continentals 6-8mo from George James created strong bidding with 20 Steers £550-£612 and Heifers £542-£575 and all sold well.

ABERDEEN ANGUS

Still enjoying a flying trade for all ages and sorts. Best Steers to £1248 for heavy 34mo beasts from Wallmead Farms Partnership. A cracking Steer from George Wyatt sold to £1198 with a nice pair of Steers from Ingsdon Farm Ltd £1185. Younger Steers were in demand with a well grown 14mo Steer to £915 from S Powell. Another well grown 12mo Steer enjoyed spirited bidding to £890 from PJ & A Boulton. A nice run of freshly weaned Angus Steers 4m/o from Witcombe Farm Partners enjoyed competitive bidding and sold well at £342. Very few Angus Heifers forward today with a premium for fleshed types to £1000 from DO Webb. Bulls to £825 from Nigel Masters and younger Heifers from £690-£695. Weaned Heifers from Witcombe Farm Partners met keen bidding to £302.

FEEDING BULLS

Feeding Bulls saw firm bidding although only limited numbers on offer. South Devon 14mo Bulls to £885, £865 & £835. Limousin x 7mo to a very strong £830.

HEREFORDS

A larger entry forward met another strong demand with farm assured, named sires still commanding a premium. Quality turn out Steers regularly over £1000 with well fleshed types to £1005 from George Wyatt and £1020 from Hugo James T/A Townhill Farming. Forward Steers also sold well from £1102 Tom Bartlett to £1120 from P J Mattick. Framed younger Steers wanted from £960 from Wilverley Farm to £972 from Tina Pavey T/A Highgrove Farm. Forward Heifers met a fast trade selling from £955-£1080 from P J Mattick and bullers to £790 from Wilverley Farm to £865 from Hugo James. Younger Heifers with potential regularly over £500 from G W James to £550 from J Forrester.

FRIESIANS

Trade a touch easier today, but still demand for the right things, A cracking run of Friesians from Robert, Ann & Jane Mayo which topped at £850 with others at £822. A nice run of medium Steers from Knapp Farm Ltd which sold to £770 with others at £750. Smaller younger Friesians in demand again today with a nice run of 10 month Friesians from C R Webber topped at £372 & £355.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Tremendous trade with fast bidding for forward types with good potential. Vendors encouraged to take advantage of this trade over the summer months. Limousin Steers set the trade selling to £1120 from PW CC & JC Gould to £1150 & £1215 from Tom Bartlett and British Blue Steers equally sought after to £1098 from Alan Gregory, £1100 from Knapp Farm Ltd to £1195 from Tite Partners. Younger Blondes sold well to £1132 from S T Poulson. Heifers met an outstanding trade with British Blue Heifers from £1055-£1200 from George Wyatt and just topped at £1202 by Tite Partners. Younger Bulling Heifers wanted with Simmental Heifers to £900 from P J Mattick and Limousin Heifers to £842 from Wilverley Farm and £855 from PJ & A Boulton.
