YOUNG CONTINENTALS

A really good show of younger Continental cattle once again this week. Demand was quite outstanding for all cattle on offer with some excellent runs commanding a premium. A quality consignment from Derek Smith and family of 90 home bred Charolais steers and heifers (9-11mo) were a particular highlight. Their best 25 steers all sold in advance of £900 with a further 45 head over £860. Their heifers easily settled between £700 and £760. Outstanding Charolais steers from the Stevens family peaked at £995. Plenty of other well presented steers settled in advance of £800 with heifers of equal quality regularly from £750. The dairy bred types also met a firm demand and interest looks set to improve further.

HEREFORDS (133)

Yearling Hereford steers generally settled in advance of £650 with well presented types to £722 from Holway Farms, £720 from John & Sue Stretton and £700 from FW Selby. Younger steers (9mo) equally sought to £645 from B & MJ Richards. Yearling heifers a little more scarce with the best today to £790 from Harry Griffin with the remaining smaller sorts settling either side of the £570 mark. The stronger fleshed cattle were more scarce but well presented steers topped at £1000 from CD Green & Partners. Other steers with farming potential generally settled in advance of £800 to £850 from SD & MJ Tibbs and £825 from J Trott & Sons. Forward heifers also topped at £1000 presented by WJ Witt & Sons with others to £910 from RW Courage & Son and £890 from SD & MJ Tibbs. Most of the heifers on offer today (17-20mo) settled in advance of £700 with nice types to £800 from B Simpson and J & J Hawkins. More forward cattle with named sires and farm assured would have been well sold.

ANGUS (238)

The younger Angus cattle met a flying trade with plenty of steers selling in advance of the £800 mark. Smart sorts (15mo) from BC & JM Rigler and HP & J Flux topped at £885 with others easily to £860 from both Clive House and EG Hedges & Son, £850 from Holway Farms and £830 from Christine Yorke. Yearling heifers met an equally brisk demand to £790 again from BC & JM Rigler, £740 from David Fry and £702 from Clive House. The named sire and farm assured forward Angus sparked very brisk bidding and regularly sold in advance of £1000. Cracking sorts from GA Potter & Son were a highlight with their steers to £1220 and heifers to £1115. Younger steers (only 18mo) from Rossiter & Son sold very well to £1148. Well presented steers from DL & VRJ Higgins & Son, AE & BL Harris and WCG Simmons all topped the £1100 mark. Other fleshed heifers were keenly contested from £950 to £1050 from Hardwick Bros, £1040 from J & J Hawkins and £1025 from DL & VRJ Higgins & Sons. Many more would have sold to advantage on this fantastic trade.

FRIESIANS (129)

The younger Friesian cattle generally met a firm trade with the best today peaking at £658 (15mo) from SD & MJ Tibbs. Most smaller types sold around the £550 mark. The stronger fleshed cattle met a brighter demand with good sorts easily from £850 to £935 from AE & BL Harris, £930 from FJ Lessey & Son and £900 from IP Eastment. The medium feeding steers with potential regularly from £700 to £750 from both BC & JM Rigler and BJ Wallbridge & Son.
