STEERS TO £1,225 HEIFERS TO £1,218

The larger company of buyers ringside kept quality bred and reared stores at a premium but a number of cattle showing signs of the very dry summer were discounted.

SUCKLER COWS & CALVES

Not too many on offer but generally a lively trade for those forward which saw prices £1070 - £850. Quality Pedigree Charolais breeding bulls from the Currell family sold well to £1280.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

The single suckled Charolais, Simmental and Limousin were wanted and saw lively bidding throughout. Grand single suckled Simmental steers and heifers 8-11mo from local vendor Tony Sage produced strong prices with steers £850 - £785. Heifers from the same home at £670. Steve Crossman continuing to produce good conformation Charolais steers 8-12mo at £662. A super consignment of Simmental x Friesian steers and heifers 12-15mo from regular vendors GM & S Silvester. Buyers wanting the better bred cattle which saw their steers to £752 and heifers from the same home at £600. Overall a number of cattle displaying signs of the extreme hot summer and lack of grass but eventually all cattle were sold. More buyers coming forward with a much fuller ring than of late.

HEREFORDS, LUINGS & SHORTHORNS

A good entry of Hereford and Luings today with some solid cattle forward which enjoyed competitive bidding throughout. Only a few best Native steers forward selling to £1050 from RW & HL Young & Sons for strong Hereford steers. A good entry of medium types selling up to £960 from HG Davey, with others to £880 from Rick Manley & Collin Moore, £872 from Sam Allen and £838 from Lester Wall.

A cracking run of Luings forward from New Forest Luig which looked well sold at £782 and £760. Smaller and younger Hereford steers attracted strong bidding throughout with a nice run from Tom Bravin selling to £742, with others to £750 from Sam & Harry Foot.

Hereford heifers continue to meet a strong demand with yearling heifers to £520 from Tom Bravin and £555 from Andy Neill. Medium heifers wanted and sold well to £678 from RD & CM Stevens to £760 from PH Creed. Fleshed heifers in demand to £828 from AG Wilmott & Son to £830 from Lester Wall. Young Shorthorn heifers sold to £500 from WJ Locke and fleshed, forward Shorthorn heifers sold to an amazing £1015 from TA Patchett.

ABERDEEN ANGUS

More Angus consigned this week with the quality, well-bred and fed types selling well. The strongest steers topped at £1105 from HG Davey. Other large framed steers to £1050 from LF Nicholls & Sons and HG Davey. Many other consignments of steers carrying flesh achieving over £1000. Slightly younger forwards from Sam & Harry Foot reached £990 for 20mo. Heifers from Wild Cherry Farm reached £960 and £940 from C & J Smart. Medium framed forward heifers from Dave Merrett to £665 and £600 from GM & S Silvester.

A cracking consignment of well-bred single suckled Angus from AM & RS Rich were competitively bid for reaching £938 for 11mo. Another good consignment from R C Cox achieved £672 for 7mo with heifers not far behind.

FRIESIANS

Fewer Friesians on offer today, but those forward enjoyed competitive bidding all day. Best steers to £800 from CV Salmon, good medium sorts from A Bown to £722 with others to £688 from PH Creed. Quality yearlings to £462 from GM & S Silvester & Son.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Forward Continentals close to finishing held a strong demand in line with the improving finished trade and vendors were rewarded for selling late summer. Plainer, older types were discounted. British Blue steers set the trade of the day with quality reared younger steers from £1005 to £1160 (21mo) from Ingsdon Farm Ltd and fleshed 20mo to £1100 from A Bown. Limousin steers met the fastest trade to £1225 from Paul Hurd and his Fleckvieh's sold well from £1100 to £1178. Young Simmental steers also wanted to £1050 (21mo) from Ingsdon Farm Ltd.

Heifers met a tremendous demand with Blondes another highlight of the day with Olly & Jenny Hurd's quality heifers selling from £1040, £1115 to a massive £1218 only 23mo. Young British Blue heifers met keen bidding to £1062 20mo from A Bown and £950 20mo from Harry Fry. Forward Limousin heifers wanted and sold from £1050 to an amazing £1135 all from Paul Hurd.
