YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another good selection of young Continentals this week with the well presented types easily over £750. A cracking entry of Blondes from RJ Sully & Son met a fantastic trade with their steers to £870 and heifers £735. A quality consignment of Simmental suckled calves (8mo) from PJ & PF Samways sold well with their quality steers topping at a strong £830. More nice Simmentals from SJ & MT Carey sparked interest with their steers to £760 and heifers to £608. Shapely Simmental steers (9mo) from SJ Atkinson & partners peaked at £782. Other Continental steers with potential keenly contested with Blues to £790 from Emmett Farm & Fencing. Some useful consignments of Charolais on offer this week with steers (13mo) to £738 from A White and much younger sorts (4mo) to £600 from J Gray. More strong top quality types would have sold to advantage on this trade. Young Continental heifers in demand generally from £650. The dairy bred cattle also met a brisk demand from £550 although not quite the quality of previous weeks.

ANGUS

The younger Angus cattle met another buoyant demand with the best named sired types particularly wanted. Steers (10-12mo) regularly settled in advance of £650 with stronger types to £785 from DS Currell, £780 from DW Hodges Ltd and £760 from Woodbridge Partners. Younger suckled steers (8mo) sold well to £700 from J Crofts. Yearling heifers more scarce peaking at £665 from DW Hodges Ltd. The medium framed farming types also wanted to £875 from High House Farm and £850 from DW Hodges Ltd. The best forward cattle today were more scarce but in strong demand with steers to £1110 and heifers to £970 both from DL & VRJ Higgins & Sons.

HEREFORDS

Named sire and farm assured Herefords continue to spark interest with young steers (15mo) topping at a cracking £788 from MH Rossiter. Other well presented yearling steers wanted to £735 from Tony Berry and £685 from RE & D Woodward. Similar aged heifers in short supply with nice suckled types to £598 again from RE & D Woodward. Some well presented stronger framed Herefords sold well with the best steers to £1130 from DL & VRJ Higgins & Sons and £1088 from CG Capon. Medium farming steers wanted from £800 to £895 from C & R Padfield, £848 from High House Farm and £835 from Graham Spiller. No forward heifers on offer this week but the medium bulling types generally settled around the £780 mark.

FRIESIANS

A few useful consignments of young Friesians today saw the best steers to £545 from D Withers and £485 from Will Abraham. The plentiful smaller cross bred sorts sold well for their types generally settled around the £350 mark. Some stronger farming sorts from James Churchill sold well topping at £835 with others to £790 from CG Capon. Plenty of medium cattle with potential sold well settling around the £700 mark.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Forward Continentals met another flying demand with framed feeders easily over £900. Cracking Blondes from Fosseway Farms were a highlight with their steers to £1190 and heifers to £1042. Limousins wanted with younger steers (17mo) to £940 from Woodbridge Farm Partners and bulling heifers to £880 from Church Farm Publow. Shapely younger Blue steers from K Young peaked at £925 (17mo) with smart heifers easily from £900 to £962 from MA Campbell Hill, £930 from C Tucker and £920 from DL & VRJ Higgins & Sons. Simmental heifers also from DL & VRJ Higgins & Sons sold well to £995. More of these well presented framed types would have sold to advantage on this trade.
