### ORGANIC CATTLE (46)

One of our smaller entries of organics this month but demand remains strong and more could have been sold to advantage. A grand consignment from Gore Farm Partnership produced wonderful prices with their South Devon steers topping at £1260 and Shorthorns (19-20mo) to £1235. French Aubrac cattle from the same home to £1188. Dairy cross cattle varied in quality with leaner Brown Swiss steers to £440 from AJ Portch.

### SUCKLER CATTLE & FEEDING BULLS

Trade was firm today for the cows & calves with some nice types on offer. Limousin cows with steer calves saw strong bidding from £1020 to £1160 from F Denning & Son.
