SUCKLER CATTLE

A small entry of suckler cattle sold to a large complement of purchasers to see Friesian cows with Angus calves at foot to £1280 from Gareth Edwards. Pedigree Shorthorn heifers with Pedigree heifer at foot to £920 from WJ Locke.

YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Another good entry of young Continentals this week with a number of annual consignments on offer. Cracking Charolais steers peaked at £1005 from PM & JE Batstone & Son with Blondes not far behind at £915 from Bramble Farms and Blues to £900 from Tite Partners. Suckled Charolais (6-7mo) from Tim Mallet set the trade with his steers from £700 to £815 and his heifers peaking at £715. RF Stratton & Co's annual consignment of Continental suckled calves (7-9mo) followed and met a brisk demand with their Charolais steers easily from £835 to £855 and heifers to £752. Salers from the same home wanted with steers to £780 and heifers to £695. Other well presented cattle included Limousin steers at £850 from C & W Hannam & Son and Simmentals to £748 from Lockerley Hall Farm. The dairy bred cattle also met a firm demand and continue to spark interest with steers generally from £650 and heifers from £600.

ANGUS

Some cracking runs of younger Angus cattle this week with a large consignment from Peter Wade setting the trade with his steers to £590 (7mo) and heifers to £505. A run of 50+ suckled Angus from PA King followed with his steers to £540 (7mo) and heifers to £470. Smart suckled calves (6-7mo) from JM Salmon & Son wanted with their steers to £778 and heifers to £715. Quality types from Gore Farm Partnership also sparked interest with their steers to £780. Other well presented yearling steers sold well topping at £880 from AM & RS Rich and £785 from D & PR Tibbs & Son with the best heifers today to a cracking £945 from JJ Taylor & Son. The forward Angus cattle met a buoyant demand with the best steers from Sarah & Helen Webb to £1175. Other fleshed steers to £1078 from BL Tayler & Partners and £1060 from both Roger Few & family and D & PR Tibbs &

Son. Forward heifers sold equally as well peaking at £1038 again from Sarah & Helen Webb with others to £1000 from MA & PR Crabb, £990 from Rossiter & Son and £975 from FF & J Down.

HEREFORDS

Herefords wanted as always particularly those with a named sire and from a farm assured holding. A run of young suckled calves (7mo) from Peter Wade set the trade with his steers to £635 and heifers to £530. Other well presented yearling steers wanted to £890 from Peter Baxandall and £885 from RE & RA Shepard with other steers regularly from £780. Yearling heifers topped at £685 from RC Garraway with more wanted. The forward Herefords were also more scarce than of late with the best steers today grossing £1135 from Sarah & Helen Webb. Heifers from the same home topped at £905.

FRIESIANS

Not too many Friesian cattle on offer this week as to be expected at this time of year. Nevertheless those on offer met a steady demand despite the deadweight pricing restructure. The best forward steers today topped at £1040 from Paul Hurd with leaner types to £865 from the same home. Medium farming sorts wanted to £730 from SH & RS Weeden with yearling steers to £478 from WG Whatley and £468 from Craigs Dairy. Montbeliardes (15mo) from BL Tayler & Son peaked at £710.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

The best fleshed forward Continentals continue to sell in advance of the £1000 mark with some cracking types today topping the £1100 mark. Smashing Limousin steers from Sarah & Helen Webb peaked at £1240 with Charolais to £1188 and Simmentals to £1145 both from Betty Chiswell. Other quality steers wanted with Simmentals to £1130 from MA & PR Crabb, £1065 from MS Coole & Son and Blues to £1000 from R & G Sheppard & Son. The forward heifers met an equally brisk demand but were more scarce with more wanted. Fleshed Blue heifers topped at a sensational £1155 from J Smart with Limousins to £1030 from AH Corp & Son. Bulling types generally from £800 to £900.
