Another exceptional sized entry this week and demand remains as strong as ever!

### YOUNG CONTINENTALS

**STEERS:** Some cracking steers on offer this week with the well presented single suckled steers sparking fantastic bidding. Blondes peaked at £1058 from ST Poulson with Charolais closely following at £1020 from Russell Bros & Co and Simmentals at £1000 from D & GJ Stevens. Plenty of other good sorts sold in advance of £850 with Limousins to £960 from SL King and Blues to £885 from Knoll Farm Partnership. Cracking younger Charolais (8mo) sold very well to £878 from Sarah Jackson.

**HEIFERS:** An equally buoyant trade for all today's heifers with plenty selling in advance of £750. Simmentals and Blues settled either side of the £800 with nice types to £805 from I Watson and £798 from Avery & Co. Smart Charolais from STC Holdings topped at £900 with others easily to £882 from D & GJ Stevens. Younger Blues (8mo) wanted to £720 from PM & K Trippick.

The dairy bred types met another good trade with no signs of demand easing. Overall another tremendous sale.

## **HEREFORDS (132)**

Not quite so many younger Herefords this week but those on offer met a very brisk demand. As expected the named sire cattle sparked the strongest interest with both steers and heifers (13mo) to £840 from Knoll Farm Partnership and Pottick Pigs respectively. Most steers generally settled around the £650 mark with nice types to £738 from Avery & Co and JB Strawbridge. Heifers traded around the £550 mark today with good yearlings to £660 from B Rose & Son and £580 from Wintershill Estates. The forward cattle were equally a bit short this week with more wanted to satisfy demand. Steers topped at £1000 from HME Gulliford with others to £992 from JB Strawbridge and £900 from

WJ & MA Whitford. The handful of stronger heifers peaked at £960 from MJ & RD Russell with smaller bulling sorts generally around the £750 to £800 mark.

## ANGUS (268)

Another flying trade for the Angus cattle and those with named sires and from a farm assured holding were particularly wanted. A cracking consignment of steers (10-12mo) from Longford Farms met a fantastic demand to £985, £965 and £892. Other well presented steers sold well to £882 from KM & JL Green, £875 from Norridge Farms and £865 from Avery & Co. Some smart yearling heifers met a bright demand to £865 from GT White & Son. Others regularly from £630 to £775 from MR Meredith and £735 from Knoll Farm Partnership. The stronger Angus were a highlight with a quality consignment of steers from LS Howes topping at £1200 and £1150. Other steers easily to £1070 from Virgin & Sons, £1010 from VL Vincent & Son and £965 from W Weaver. Fleshed Angus heifers topped at £1070 from R Carpenter with a consignment from Longford Farms peaking at £990. Many more would have sold to a flying trade.

## FRIESIANS (218)

Only and handful of young Friesians this week with a nice consignment from AG Hinks & Sons peaking at £620. A run from WH Perry & Son sold well with their younger steers (15mo) to £582 and stronger sorts from £695 to £845. There was a stronger entry of forward Friesians compared to recent weeks and these framed types were keenly contested. A consignment from PW Keen & Sons topped at £1025 with others from the same home regularly from £912. Other farming sorts to £870 from LS Howes, £835 from Avery & Co, £830 from MR Meredith and £815 from NJ & CL Parker.

## FORWARD CONTINENTALS

The large company of buyers produced another amazing Spring trade with demand again outstripping supply. **STEERS:** Another phenomenal trade for the forward steers this week with the best easily over £1100. Cracking Charolais from STC Holdings topped the day trading from £1215 to £1265. Other quality types included Blondes from ST Poulson to £1160 and Simmentals to £1170 from VL Vincent & Son. Blues regularly from £1000 to £1140 again from BJ Stainer & Sons, £1110 from PW Keen & Sons and £1080 from JE Cock & Son. Not so many Limousins forward with this week well presented types to £1030 again from VL Vincent & Son.

**HEIFERS:** Another fast demand for all breeds with some quality Charolais easily to £1250 from STC Holdings and £1200 from A White. Well fleshed Limousins topped at £1095 with Simmental closely following at £1072 from S & J Symes. Blues again from PW Keen & Sons easily to £1052. Medium bulling sorts met a brighter demand and regularly traded from £820 to £940.

Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided.

**If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.**

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
