YOUNG CONTINENTALS

Some stronger runs of Continental steers this week with the best soaring over the £900 mark. Cracking suckled Limousin steers from BJ Isaacson topped at £1025 with his other pens to £920 and £862. Some quality suckled Limousin calves (only 6mo) from Gavin Doyle set the trade with his best steers £865 with his heifers to £755. Other Limousins keenly contested with a run from

Nick Bond selling well with his steers to £845 and heifers to £700. Some smart Charolais from Mike Hoppe were a highlight with his steers to £988 and heifers to £842. Suckled Simmentals from Nick and Molly Doggrell sparked keen interest with their steers to £968 and heifers to £830. Other good Simmental steers easily sold to £900 from JF Curtis and £875 from J Coleberd. The dairy bred types met a stronger demand today with Charolais steers from TC & H Marks selling well to £925 whilst their Blue heifers settled at £760. Trade only set to improve as some exceptional runs of cattle come forward over the next month.

BEEF SCHEMES: NAMED SIREs

Named sire cattle particularly Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn and Devon breeds are of particular importance when selling stock at market. Stringent measures are now in force, specifically **DNA testing**, when animals enter rearing units and/or at the point of slaughter to check that they are by the registered sire provided. **If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.** The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.

Another good show of Angus cattle this week with the named sire farm assured types particularly wanted. Young suckled steers from Mike Hoppe topped at £978 with other well presented steers to £890 from Will Sprake, £860 from Richard Salter and £830 from David Hawkins. Much younger steers (9mo) wanted to £615 from CD Griffin Partners and £615 from Nick Bond. Yearling heifers more scarce to £682 from Richard Salter. The stronger Angus cattle met a buoyant demand with steers to £1142 from DJ Kinderman. Other fleshed steers wanted to £1070 from MW & BM Cox & Son, £1050 from Bill and Valerie Masters and £1020 from Freeman Bros. Forward heifers wanted to £970 from TC & H Marks Ltd and £848 again from MW & BM Cox & Son. Bulling heifers met a brisk trade to £868 from RP Loxton and £840 from JK Simpson.

HEREFORDS

Not too many Herefords on offer this week but those forward met a brisk demand. The handful of yearling steers topped at £800 from C & L Farming with others to £770 from Richard & Wendy Ford and £770 from Nick Bond. Heifers very few and far between and more would have sold to advantage. A well fleshed forward steer from Robert Barton sold well to £1038 with others farming sorts to £975 from LP Shackell & Son and £915 from the Few family. The small selection of stronger heifers peaked at £985 from JK Simpson with bulling sorts to £840 from RP Loxton and £830 from Robert Barton. More named sire types would have sold to advantage.

FRIESIANS

The Friesians met another solid demand with the small selection of younger steers generally selling well. A good consignment from Bowerman & Sons set the trade topping with his yearling steers to £570 and slightly older types to £720 and £770. No framed forward steers on offer today whilst the best medium sorts peaked at £870 from Dennis Norman & Phillip Randall.

FORWARD CONTINENTALS

Trade very similar to last week with the prices settling at pleasing levels but perhaps not as high as seen in previous sales. Well presented and fleshed cattle sparked the strongest interest with a cracking consignment of Blondes from RJ Sully & Son topping the day. Their steers peaked at

£1158, £1155 and £1108 whilst their heifers grossed £1090 and £980. Other smart Continental steers keenly contested with Limousins to £1135 from J Sprake & Partners and Blues to £1105 from Bill and Valerie Masters and £1030 from LP Shackell & Son. Medium feeding steers with potential regularly from £850 with Simmentals to £1005 from DJ Kinderman and Charolais to £988 from Mike Hoppe. Other forward heifers more scarce this week with some nice Blues topping at £980 from J Smart with bullers to £900 from R Loxton. Charolais heifers again from Mike Hoppe settled at £910 with his Simmentals to £900. Medium fleshed bulling Limousins from Alan Pike wanted to £878.
