ORGANIC CATTLE (137)

Another excellent show of Organic cattle this month with the well presented quality sorts commanding very brisk bidding. Simmentals from Chave & Foster topped the section with their steers to £1480 and heifers to £1365. A run of named sire native bred cattle from EJ Lippiatt sold extremely well with his Angus steers to £1380 and Hereford heifers to £1165. Yearling Hereford steers from the same home topped at £1190. A consignment of Shorthorns from Sandley Farm Partnership were keenly contested with their steers peaking at £1170. Cracking young Blue steers (only 8mo) from AH Hoddinott & Son were a highlight settling at £1035 and £1015! Friesian steers and heifers from Childhay Organic Dairy met a brisk demand to £945 and £1165 respectively. Many more quality sorts of all ages would have well on this exceptional trade.

ANGUS

A strong entry of Angus cattle this week of all ages with demand fierce from start to finish. Yearling Angus steers from ME Hoppe sold very well to £900 with others regularly from £800 to £885 from Lockerley Hall Farm and £818 from MD & DR James. Yearling heifers equally sought with top quality sorts again from ME Hoppe peaking at an excellent £950 (only 9 months of age). Other dairy bred heifers generally settled around the £700 mark. The stronger forward cattle met an exceptional demand with steers topping at £1278 from WD & VJ Masters. Other quality steers easily from £1000 to £1260 from RE Nuttall & Partners and £1098 from I & J Holmes & Co Ltd. Forward heifers more scarce but those on offer were very keenly contested to £1122 again from RE Nuttall & Partners. Many more of all ages would have sold well on this impressive trade.

HEREFORDS

Not quite so many Herefords on offer today compared to recent week and more named sire types would have sold to advantage. Yearling steers generally settled in advance of £700 with the best steers peaking at £802 from S Powell. Similar aged heifers wanted from £600 to £705 from RE & D Woodward. The stronger steers were in demand with quality types from WD & VJ Masters topping at £1145. Forward heifers few and far between peaking at £1030 from R Kendall.

FRIESIANS

A much stronger entry than of late which sparked a very buoyant trade. A large consignment of farmed Friesian, Swedish and Danish cross steers from P Denning & Son set the trade regularly selling in advance of £900. Their Montbeliardes peaked at £1080 whilst their best pen of Holsteins topped at £1060 with Danish types to £1015 and Swedish Reds to £972. Other framed Friesians to £1020 from RC Few & Sons. The younger cattle met a firm trade with those showing potential settling in advance of £500. A useful consignment from C & F Street Partnership peaked £610 with others to £585 from LJ Doggrell Ltd and £555 from R & J Dacombe.

If at point of sale you are not 100% sure, please DO NOT sell your animal(s) with a sire.

The financial implications of providing an incorrect sire at point of sale will be considerable.
