**STORE CATTLE (189)  
STEERS TO £1,050 HEIFERS TO £950**

Fewer stores consigned this month however the trade seems to have settled as demand for yarding types increases. The recent increase in grain and straw prices have not installed much confidence for finishers however plenty of buyers in attendance for all breeds.

**ANGUS**

Mostly medium framed forward Angus consigned with enough buyers in attendance to support a fair trade much the same as the Friday market. The best steer topped at £980 from R & J Dacombe followed by £930 from J & M King-Brian. Medium framed steers to £860 from RH & CM Johnston and £820 from JR & RH Williams. Angus heifers to £885 for well-bred suckler types with plenty of time to finish. A well presented young steer from the Hayter family reached £680 for 16mo with a good run of younger steers from the Gerring Partners to £640 for 16mo. Younger heifers from the same consignment to £595 for 14mo.

**HEREFORDS & DEVONS**

The Hereford & South Devon x cattle saw the top end of the quality and trade today. Well covered Hereford x steers from the Johnston family produced strong prices to £1045, closely followed by J & M King-Brian's Hereford x steer 16mo at £900. Quality South Devon x continental steers and heifers still from the King-Brian's sold well to £1050 and £948 respectively. The dry weather showing its effect on the cattle with more leaner types forward than normal.

**CONTINENTALS**

A good run of Continental cattle and more younger types than of late. More heavier fleshed types were needed to take advantage of the rise in the finish prices. However, those on offer had good conformation and generally sold to a firm trade. Super Black Limousin x heifers (20mo) from Brunt Partners to £858 and their steers to £900. Overage British Blue x steers and heifers from NJ Tory & Partners saw competitive bidding to £950 on both accounts. A grand entry from J & M King-Brain saw their 19mo Limousin steers peak at £1050 and heifers from the same home at £880. Overall more fleshed cattle were needed throughout.

## **FRIESIANS**

Several consignments of well grown Friesians selling to a similar trade to Friday markets with the fleshier sorts in great demand and keenly sought. Forward British types from Brunt Partners reaching £845 with Holsteins from HE Cotton & Son to £838. Medium framed sorts trading between £650 and £695. Fewer bidders for the younger grazing types although a little more demand after the recent grass growth.

### **FAT CATTLE (5)**

Some terrific animals forward just short of numbers. Fed sorts from P Rood & Son Ltd topped the market at £1,354.19 or 189p/kg for a British Blue heifer closely followed by £1,315.96 or 197p/kg for JC Stainer's Limousin steer. Trade generally firmer for all types.

### **BARREN COWS (16)**

A much smaller entry forward of mainly Beef types with a ring full of buyers wanting fleshed and better types. P Rood & Son Ltd saw their best shaped British Blue cows sell to 166p/kg, £1,116.77.
