STEERS TO £1,365

HEIFERS TO £1,170

Overall another excellent day with over 500 head penned for sale. Today's sale included a consignment of Angus cows with calves at foot. These nice heavy fleshed cows with strong calves at foot sparked interest from £1000 topping at £1210.

CONTINENTALS: A tremendous entry of forward Continentals with plenty of quality types on offer. Demand was quite exceptional from start to finish with plenty of steers in excess of £1200. Cracking Blue steers peaked at £1365 with others closely following at £1300. Others well presented Blue steers settled at £1195 and £1170. Blue heifers were equally sought to £1180 with others to £1095 and £1070. Limousin and Simmentals also met a brisk demand with all the best types regularly from £1150 to £1200 and smart Charolais steers to £1240.

NATIVE BREEDS: Some well fleshed **Angus** were very keenly contested with the named sire sorts in particularly sparking very brisk bidding. Cracking Angus steers topped at £1285 with others to £1250 and £1230. A consignment of organic steers and heifers met a buoyant trade to £1230 and £950 respectively. Commercial Angus heifers peaked at £1128 with other fleshed types to £1040 and £1035. Medium framed steers also sold well from £850 with heifers generally around the £800 mark. Fewer **Herefords** than of late but those on offer nevertheless met a fast demand. Steers topped at £1168 with medium sorts to £955 from Briars Farm Ltd and £925. Heifers topped at £1048 again, £988 and £930.

FRIESIANS:

The forward Friesians met a competitive trade with Holsteins topping at £1045 and £1035. Others to £982 and £980. Medium sorts generally from £750 and in line with prices achieved on a Friday.

Overall another excellent day in the fat ring but far too few barren cows to satisfy demand.
Many thanks to all vendors and purchasers for their continued support.

2 BARREN COWS: Devons to 129.5p/kg.

65 FAT (Max. 214.50p/kg & £1,485 Av. 180.84p/kg): Another cracking run of Continentals topped the day with best steers to 214p/kg, 213p/kg and 210.5p/kg grossing over £1400 on 7 occasions. Blue steers topped at 207.5p/kg and £1398 whilst Limousin steers topped at 207p/kg and £1465. A handful of heifers from the same home sold very well with Herefords to 213.5p/kg and £1248 and Charolais to 210p/kg and £1093. A large entry of Friesian steers met a brisk trade from 145.5p/kg to 165p/kg. Overall a very good trade and more would have sold to advantage.
