Please note: Licences are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time.

Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have <u>tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test</u>, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence). Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home. The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.
