Strong demand for TB restricted stores at Frome's monthly sale with all consigned selling to a fair trade despite the expense of finishing. Enough buyers in attendance for all types with trade much the same as Friday markets for stronger sorts.

### ANGUS & HEREFORDS

Quality consignments of Angus with named sires and farm assured were competitively bid for. Well grown steers from the Few family topped the day at £1,090 with similar types from JM & PJ Evans to £1,070 and £1,060 from AW Doel. Forward heifers from the Few family again achieved £1,000, exceeded by slightly older heifers from AW Doel & Sons to £1,050. Organic steers with good frames and potential from RG Perkins & Sons reaching £875. Herefords certainly come into their own this week with a number of good types available. SH Lawrence & Sons producing some strong 22mo steers to £1,045 closely followed by Organic Herefords from the Perkins family to £1,022. Heifers again from the Lawrence's to £855. Younger steers 17mo from the Grey Partnership saw firm bidding to £785. Overall a very firm trade throughout for these traditional types.

### CONTINENTALS

Trade lively for the forward Continentals and more fleshier sorts could have been well sold. Deep bodied Blue x steers and heifers saw competitive bidding throughout the sale. Best Blue x steers from PW Keen & Son to £1,095, very closely followed by their heifers at £1,082. More Blues from the Johnston family saw steers to £1,040 and heifers from D & P Yeatman to £970. Younger Blues from TD Sharp & Son produced more interest than of late with 12 - 13mo steers to £628 and 12mo heifers to £605. A few Organic cattle presented for sale this month saw good bidding with smart Simmental heifers from the Perkins family to £850. Less demand for younger stores however some quality consignments selling to a better trade than anticipated. A cracking bunch of Limousin heifers from JJ Taylor & Son reached £845 for 12 - 14mo. Blue steers from Lottisham Farms Ltd to £740 for 13mo.

## FRIESIANS

Mostly medium framed and younger steers consigned selling to a similar trade to Friday markets. Well grown fleshier types from PW Keen reached £905 with similar steers from Will Weaver to £842. Younger feeding steers harder to sell as usual however enough buyer around the ring to support a reasonable trade.

Far too few cattle forward to satisfy the strong demand for both over and under age. Limousin x steers to 191.50p/kg from JC Stainer, Blue x heifers to 184.50p/kg from Rawlings-Dickin, Angus to 190p/kg from JM & PJ Evans and Herefords to 178p/kg.

### BARREN COWS (37)

A good TB restricted entry of cows met a strong competitive trade especially for the quality meat sorts with Hann Farming's heavy Friesian topping the day at £1,213.96 132.50p/kg. TR Horsington £1,049.58 126p/kg and a further 2 cows from Hann Farming £1,025 127p/kg and £1,017 124p/kg. Other grades met a firm trade although plain cows were variable.

Beef cows - a good shape young Blue X cow from TFT Handy topped at 156.50p/kg. Herefords to £811.97 104.50p/kg from JJ Taylor £811.68 and Friesians 114p/kg from KJ Osborne & Partners. Salers to 105.50p/kg from CG Young.
