**STEERS TO £1,275**

**HEIFERS TO £1,065**

Some quality cattle presented for sale this week with the plenty of buyers ringside to compete for these best types. Trade generally more steady as the finished prices ease but overall interest was equally as strong today as at any Friday sale.

**CONTINENTALS:** An excellent consignment of well fleshed steers were a highlight with Limousins to £1275, Blues to £1255 and Simmentals to £1200. Cracking Blue steers also equalled the top spot of £1275. Today's sale included a large run of Blue steers with strong types to £1235, £1175, £1150, £1105 and £1035. More fleshed Simmental steers sparked brisk bidding to £1210 and £1155. Younger farming steers met a brisk trade with Blues to £880 and Blondes to £840. Heifers not quite so plentiful but the smart types were equally as sought. Blues topped at £1065, Limousins at £1000 and Simmental at £900.

**NATIVE BREEDS:** Some well fleshed **Angus** forward this month with the best steers to £1260 from and £1255. Other well presented named sire steers wanted to £1125 with younger farming types to £990 and £960. Organic steers topped at £980 with young heifers to £690. Angus heifers topped at £1060 with others to £975, £970 and £945. Younger heifers with potential generally sold in advance of £670 to £795, £790 and £710. Some good **Herefords** on sale today with forward steers easily to £1200 and £1150, £1135, £1098 and £1090. Younger farming steers regularly from £700 to £855 and £750. Hereford heifers topped at £920 from GR Gillett with others medium sorts to £868 and £868. The very young and small cattle were slightly more difficult to place given the time of year.

**FRIESIANS:** A good show of Friesians today with the stronger types topping at £950. Good medium farming steers wanted to £878, £842 and £838.

# BEEF CATTLE & CULL STOCK (60)

A good entry of barren cows and fat cattle this month and all met a competitive trade.

**35 BARREN COWS (Max. 143.50p/kg £1,032 Av. 99.55p/kg):** The best meat cows met a cracking trade with well fleshed Charolais to 143.5p/kg and £957. Simmentals and Herefords from the same home sold well to 126.5p/kg. Plenty of dairy cows forward with the better types keenly contested to 129.5p/kg, 127p/kg and 125.5p/kg. Only the very poor and plan settled under 80p/kg.

**25 FAT (Max. 210.00p/kg & £1,441 Av. 194.42p/kg):** Another cracking consignment topped the day with her Limousin steers to 210p/kg and £0175, Charolais steers to 209.5p/kg and £1441, Blue steers to 208.5p/kg and £1347 and Charolais heifers to 198.5p/kg and £1221. Overall this entry of 16 cattle averaged over 200p/kg and £1229. Hereford steers topped at 188.5p/kg and £1311 with heifers to 182.5p/kg and £1062. Angus steers wanted to 191.5p/kg and £1275. Overall a very buoyant trade and equal to any Wednesday.
