Although a few less cattle forward than our previous sales, the quality on offer was very pleasing with plenty of buyers ringside to support a strong trade. Both the Continental and traditional breeds all sold to high levels with bidding brisk throughout.

CONTINENTALS

A number of top quality Continentals presented today with all selling to a buoyant trade. Some top sorts from produced some excellent prices with their best Blue steers to £1250. Other well presented steers keenly contested to £1190, £1100 and £1098. Blue heifers were in abundance with several close to the £1000. Well shaped Limousins sparked brisk bidding with steers to £1098 and heifers to £938 all.

HEREFORDS / ANGUS

The traditional breeds continue to command a premium and whilst not too many **Herefords** on offer this month trade was equal to a Friday's demand. The well presented types produced a good trade with stronger steers to 940, £922 and £880. Named sire **Angus** met a flying demand with the best fleshed steers to £1158 and £1155. Feeding leaner sorts generally from £800. Fleshed heifers topped at 1005 with other good conformation sorts to £980, £965 and £890 from Will Stitch. Grazing heifers wanted from £700. Overall a cracking trade.

FRIESIANS

A good entry of fleshed Friesians met a brisk trade with a quality consignment regularly trading from £1005 to £1220. Other well fleshed types to £1090. Others with potential to £888 and £795.

FAT CATTLE (31)

Max. 200.50/kg & £1,400 (Av. 174.49p/kg)

A mixed quality entry of under and overage fat cattle met a brisk demand from start to finish. **UTM:** Limousin steers topped at 199.5p/kg and £1400 with others to £1374. Angus steers peaked at 187.5p/kg and £1048. **OTM:** A well presented run sold well with his Limousin steers to 200.5p/kg and £1064 whilst his Angus steers topped at 194p/kg and £1198. Hereford heifers from the same home to 179.5p/kg.

BARREN COWS (42)

Max. 138.50p/kg & £1,517 (Av. 111.63p/kg)

A good sized entry comprising a large percentage of foreign imports. The best Friesian meat cows topped at 138.5p/kg and £1517 with their four cows averaging a massive £1278! Other fleshed cows to 131.5p/kg and 124.5p/kg. Manufacturing types wanted with Irish imports to 127p/kg. The handful of beef cows topped at 137.5p/kg for Angus.
