STEERS TO £1,265 HEIFERS TO £1,195

A good sized entry for our November and potentially final TB sale of the year. Trade was generally stronger than anticipated considering the time of year and the lack of available housing.

CONTINENTALS: Demand for the well grown Continentals was strong with the shapely fleshed cattle sparking keen interest. A smart pair of Charolais steers sold well to £1180 with Blues steers to £1105, £1090 and £1085. Simmental steers equally sought to £1000. Cracking Limousin heifers topped at £1195 with Charolais heifers easily to £1100. Blue heifers closely followed at £1095 from and Simmentals to £1000. The younger cattle were more difficult to place but all were sold to a strong contingent of potential purchasers.

NATIVE BREEDS: Some quality consignments of native bred cattle this week met competitive bidding from start to finish. Smart **Angus** steers topped at £1225 with others easily to £1200 and £1175. Other good farming steers to £950 and £850. Angus heifers also wanted to £945 with others to £848. **Herefords** wanted with steers peaking at £1000 and £988. Younger farming steers regularly from £750 to £830 from and £820. Fewer Hereford heifers on offer with the handful of medium to younger types topping at £765. Smart Devon steers with potential to £850. The very young native cattle met a limited demand as to be expected.

FRIESIANS: Quite a selection of Friesians this month with the stronger better fleshed steers generally from £800 topping at £1000. Other framed types to £918 from and £832 . Younger Friesians and the harder feeding types met a steady demand and sold well considering the time of year.

BEEF CATTLE & CULL STOCK (74)

Pleasing to see a much larger entry compared to recent sale with plenty of buyers ringside. Trade very much in line with a clean Wednesday market with more wanted on a monthly basis.

48 BARREN COWS (Max. 116.50p/kg £904 Av. 82p/kg): The best Friesian meat cows met a strong trade with British types to 113.5p/kg with others to 107.5p/kg and 106p/kg. The leaner cows lacking cover met a level trade from 80p/kg with the plentiful poorer cross bred or imported cows still selling well for their type. The small entry of beef cow topped at 116.5p/kg for a Devon from with Angus to 114.5p/kg from SP Creed and 112.5p/kg.

26 FAT (Max. 190.00p/kg & £1,455): Another cracking run of Continentals topped the trade with her Charolais steers to 190p/kg (£1455), Limousin heifers to 185p/kg (£1141) and Charolais heifers to 184p/kg (£1074). Overall her entry of 11 quality cattle averaged 185p/kg and £1155. Hereford steers peaked at 182p/kg and £1040 with Angus heifers to 170.5p/kg.

Please note: Licences are issued on a first come first served basis & may take up to 5 working days to process. As such, short notice requests may not be issued in time.

Cattle can enter an Orange market if they have tested negative within 90 days of a new or repeat herd test, even if reactors are found (reactors must be removed from the holding prior to applying for a licence). Cattle are **NO LONGER ALLOWED** to return home. The only onward movement allowed will be to an Approved Finishing Unit (AFU) or an abattoir.
