IMPORTANT CHANGES TO LEGISLATION – PLEASE READ

VETERINARY ATTESTATIONS – EFFECTIVE 13TH DECEMBER 2023

What is Changing?

Changes in EU legislation, as from **13th December 2023**, will require all producers selling **livestock for slaughter** to have had an **annual on-farm veterinary visit** to allow their animals, and/or part of any animal, to be exported out of the UK. From 13th December 2023, producers will require a Veterinary Attestation. This will certify that an annual on-farm visit has taken place to verify the absence of notifiable diseases and provide general advice on farm biosecurity, meeting EU requirements. The Vet will provide the producer with a unique Veterinary Attestation Number, known as a “VAN” within their certificate.

What is the “VAN” number?

The Veterinary Attestation Number, known as “VAN”, is a unique reference number provided by Vets to producers within their Veterinary Attestation certificate to certify that an annual on-farm visit has taken place. A VAN number is valid for 12 months. This information will need to be provided to livestock markets, and onwards to buyers, for livestock sold for slaughter. The VAN number is made up of 20 digits as follows, including the Vets RCVS number, the CPH number the VAN corresponds to, and expiry date. For example: **1234567-12/345/6789-0624** [*MRCVS number*]-[*CPH number*]-[*Valid to the end of June 2024*].

What will you need to do?

If you are a member of a **qualifying assurance scheme (Red Tractor Assurance)** then you do not need to do anything as a **VAN number is not required**.

If you are **not Farm Assured**, you will need to provide the auctioneers with your VAN number prior to, or on arrival at the market.

For **sheep**, this will be included on an updated official sheep movement form.

For **cattle**, we will provide an updated cattle entry form to include a place to write your VAN number if necessary.

For **pigs**, the digital eAML2 form has been updated to accommodate the VAN number. Please note that the above will include **Prime, cull and store stock** as some forward store stock goes to slaughter from store markets.

We will take a note of your **VAN number** on our market system and **this will be valid for 12 months**. VAN templates can be collected from the market office or found here:

Wow, what a start to the New Year! A tremendous run of Organic cattle through the ring at Frome with close to 100 penned for sale. Excellent home bred well grown Angus from Tynning Farms created furious bidding with 20mo steers regularly over £1550, topping at £1575 and other bunches at £1455, £1390, £1310 and £1300. Heifers from the same good home equally sought at £1410, their Blue steers to £1365. Younger types from MJ & CM Durston saw 13mo Blue steers at £850. More could have been sold today.

Only a few on offer and many more wanted. Medium framed steers met a strong demand to £688 from C Thompson & Son of Malmesbury. Younger feeding steers also sold well to £438.

ANGUS

A good selection on offer but demand still ahead of supply. Forward steers and heifers wanted with fleshed steers to £1405 (34mo), £1320 (33mo) and similar heifers to £1370 (34mo) all from Andrew Wear of Compton Martin. His younger steers also met a fast trade to £1075 (only 16mo) and other heifers to £1100. Best yearling steers sold to a massive trade with 10mo to £935 from JB Carter of Isle of Wight and his 11mo heifers sold well to £815. Medium framed rearing steers also wanted with seers to £900 from C Thompson & Son of Malmesbury and £760 (16mo) from Richard & Robert Hole of Sherborne. Similar heifers with bulling potential keenly sought to £800 (16mo) from M & A Kerby of Gillingham, £745 from R & R Hole and 11mo heifers at £700 from C Thompson & Son.

HEREFORD & DEVON

An excellent trade for the few on offer. Hereford steers sold well from £1040 to £1080 and topped at £1180 (24mo) all from G & A Habershon of Bromham. Their Hereford heifers equally wanted with good bullers to £935. Others with bulling potential also met a fast trade to £858 (16mo) from M & A Kerby of Gillingham. Exceptionally well bred and reared Devon steers from Martin & Ashley Wrixon of Yeovil sold to tremendous bidding with steers to £1345 (19mo) and their younger steers to £1090.

YOUNG CONTINENTAL

An excellent entry of all ages with quality selling to an exceptional demand. Neil & Alice Glover of Yeovil set the trade for the day with their single suckled Charolais steers sired by their prize-winning bull, selling to an amazing £998 (only 7mo) and their younger steers to £915. This lead the way for the tremendous entry from Robert Bull of Winchester who showed his well-bred single suckled Blue steers and heifers out of his large suckled Blue x Angus cows. His young steers sold to an exceptional £1050 (9mo) and closely followed at £1000 and £995 (8mo). Robert young heifers equally showed well and sold to £1002 and £940 (9mo). Both of these vendors are presenting further good entries next week.

FORWARD CONTINENTAL

Best in demand and today showed confidence in the Beef industry, as well presented Limousin steers by IJ & JC Brett of Isle of Wight took top honours with their Limousin steers selling to £1638 and £1560 (all only 21mo) and their Limousin heifers to £1515 (21mo). Younger feeding steers also wanted and sold well from £990 to £1060 (16mo) from RVW & LEA Ritchens of Trowbridge.
